Burial Preserves located on Ku ʻukama Street, Huluhulu Place, in the Maui Lani Islands and Bluffs Subdivision, at the Maui Lani Regional Park, and along Kuikahi Drive/Maui Lani Parkway, Ahupua ʻa of Wailuku, District of Wailuku, TMK(s): (2) 3-8-083:038, (2) 3-8-083:003, (2) 3-8-083:008, (2) 3-8-083:009, (2) 3-8-087:017, (2) 3-8-086:055, (2) 3-8-007:150

(Members will first meet at 24 Ku ʻukama Street Burial Preserve)

- Burial Council members and Guests meet at burial preserve at 57 Ku ʻukama Street, TMK: (2) 3-8-083:038.
- Council meeting call to order and plan of site visits discussed.
- Council members and guests take a look at Burial Preserve at 57 Ku ʻukama Street as well as preserve across the street at 58 Ku ʻukama Street. Recommendations included erecting signage, more vegetation and higher vegetation buffer.
- 9:40AM. Council members and guests proceed to burial preserve down the road at 24 Ku ʻukama Street and 1 Huluhulu Place. To follow up with community members concerns of students desecrating burials (walking through Preserve), it was discussed that this preserve could be area in question. Upon viewing site, it's plausible that students would walk through preserve from Ku ʻukama Street to access Huluhulu Place. Did not witness anyone walking through preserve while on site.
- Council and guests leave preserve at 9:55AM and head toward the burial preserve at the Islands and Bluffs Subdivision, TMK: 2-3-5-087:017. Discussions ensued.
- Council and guests arrive at 10:01AM. Discussions ensued. Council and guests proceed to the Maui Lani Regional Park to continue site visits.
- 10:30AM Council and guests arrive at Maui Lani Regional Park, Maui Lani Parkway, TMK: 2-3-8-007:150. Discussions ensued.
- 10:40AM Council and guests proceed to Walgreens parking to take a look at the burial preserve located Below Walgreens right off of Maui Lani Parkway. Discussion ensued. Recommendation included better upcoming of preserve in question. Vegetation growing in preserve potential to disturb the iwi located in preserve.
