After reviewing the materials submitted, due to its lack of proximity to Hawaiian Home Lands, we do not anticipate any impacts to our lands or beneficiaries from the project. However, DHHL recommends consultation with Hawaiian Homestead community associations located within the moku of Honolulu and with other (N)ative Hawaiian organizations, to better assess potential impacts to cultural and natural resources, and other rights of Native Hawaiians.
