- NWQI update
 - Still writing assessment. Behind schedule.
 - Requested NWQI funding to pay contractors but contractors not paid because assessment not completed. Payments are made when deliverables are completed.
 - Resource concern section of assessment is the hold up since the
 resource concerns that were identified doesn't all fit for the
 Kawaihae watershed, thus creating a survey for the public to take
 to determine what other resources concerns may apply to the
 watershed.
 - MKSWCD is the entity that receives the funds and funnel it out to the contractors
- Working on CTA plan with Island Harvest
- Vehicle Liability Insurance
 - Beehive working to see what can be done
 - SWCD and HACD needing to have their own individual D&O liability (having own powers under Ch. 180) trying to work on a way to cover liability portion for vehicle coverage
 - Until then all SWCD & HACD will need to look at possibly having to get own vehicle liability



- **a.** Vehicle liability insurance through NRCS for SWCD employees doesn't really exist because the MOA doesn't state that
- **b.** Maybe looks at RCUH and what they do for vehicle liability
- **c.** Check with personnel car insurance if they cover other vehicle liability while operating someone else's car.

b. Open Discussion

- For next board meeting
 - CRP- FSA program for a cooperator to keep grazing land as is rather than develop it. High management grazing for 15 years. FSA handles the cultural resource side but they want the board to sign plan first but board doesn't sign plans until cultural resources are cleared. The FSA date is 9/11/2020 for this plan.
 - Since one of the board members can't vote on this plan, will need the remaining board members to be present and vote, possibly taking vote by email if there is no quorum for the next scheduled board meeting.
