- All posters must be created by an **individual** student, rather than a team of students
- The 2022 Stewardship Theme "Healthy Soil, Healthy Life." must be included on the front side of each poster submission to be eligible for the poster contest
- Each entry for the contest must be submitted to the Maui Soil & Water Conservation Districts with an entry form to be eligible for judging. The entry form must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian
- Although younger students will most likely receive help in planning from parents or teachers, we encourage each student to do their own work. *Note:* Entries with student handwriting and coloring will score better than those designed, drawn, and colored with adult assistance
