• Soil and Water Conservation District 75th Anniversary

- The Olinda-Kula Soil and Water Conservation District was formed on May 2, 1948, and will be celebrating its 75th anniversary in May 2023
- Mae Nakahata introduced the idea of a statewide celebration that would include a traveling display, an 18-month calendar beginning in June 2023, and to be held in conjunction with other events held on each Island
 - Pictures from all 16 Conservation Districts are needed for the traveling display
 - People to assist at the events will be needed

• New District Exploration

 Creation of a new Soil and Water Conservation District and getting more involvement with native Hawaiians

Keokea Gulch Riparian Rehabilitation Project

- Report and Updates by Michael Reyes, consultant to Central Maui Soil and Water Conservation
 District overseeing the Keokea Gulch Riparian Rehabilitation Project
 - The fencing and drip-line irrigation have been installed
 - Planting will begin on Friday, 10/28 at 9 AM and will continue every Friday after until all trees are planted
 - Plan to plant 10,000 trees overall, with approximately 100 trees planted each
 Friday
 - People are needed to assist with the planting
 - A grant application for Axis Deer Mitigation has also been submitted

• Pohakea Watershed Planning Effort

- Report and Updates by Michael Reyes, consultant to Central Maui Soil and Water Conservation
 District overseeing the Pohakea Watershed Planning Effort
 - This is a 5000-acre watershed that flows into the Ma'alaea Harbor and Bay
 - Studies have been held and the draft plan has been submitted to the State

- Maui Soil and Water Conservation District Updates, Plans, Finalization
 - Kelly Butler, Maui Soil and Water Conservation District Conservation Planner
 - Currently there are no plans for approval
 - Kelly stated that she will be participating in the Arbor Day celebration on 11/5 and the HI Farmers Union at the beginning of December
 - The Poster Contest is scheduled to close on 11/4/2022 and judging will follow

• USDA Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS)

- Report From Gerald Gregory, District Conservationist
 - Gerald stated that the contracting cycle for 2023 was currently underway
- Approval of Conservation Services Plan Presented by Gerald Gregory on behalf of Jessica Talbot,
 Natural Resources Conservation Service (NRCS) Planner
 - One plan for approval
 - All documents associated with the plan were previously emailed to the Central Maui Soil and Water District board members for review
 - Due to privacy laws, many aspects of the Environmental Quality Incentives Program (EQIP) Conservation Plans may not be fully discussed in a public forum
 - The Directors stated that they had reviewed the plan and had no questions
 - A motion to approve the plan was made by Edgar Cordero,
 Director
 - The motion was seconded by Darren Strand, Vice Chair
 - The motion to approve was voted on and carried unanimously
