- ١. WELCOME: The KSWCD Board Meeting called to order 8:06 am by Chairman Knowles.
  - Quorum present but Agenda not posted to State Calendar (Sunshine Law).
  - Welcome guest Ferrell Daste, acting CEO of Kona Hills. Project getting back on track with original vision of a collaborative effort with the community to create a sustainable coffee farm providing jobs, education, and other agricultural opportunities. This management change allows the investors, Michigan Employment Retirement System, to move forward with a remediation plan, transparency, collaborative efforts, and right sizing. Working with County, SHPD, CTAHR, and working with engineers on stormwater mitigation plans. Kona Hills has a desire to work with the schools, and able to supply SUV vehicle usage for some of these outreach partnerships. Kona Hills might be a good candidate to host the site of Hawaii State Conservation Awareness Contest in October. Working with the Konawaena Leo Club may be another good fit. Tools to capture these voices and the integration at the end of the project is something to look at. Kona Hills looks forward to working with KSWCD and hosting a bigger session with a conceptualized agenda.

#### A. REGIONAL CONSERVATION PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM (RCPP):

- National and Hawaii Associations of Conservation Districts (NACD & HACD): No updates or news on ii. board development training, districts handbooks nor 75 years of SWCD in Hawai'i, and 18-month calendars featuring each 16 districts marketing piece.

iv. District Annual Work Plan: Edits are slow but being worked on - implementing suggestions as submitted on original draft last year and incorporating in this year's newest draft.

  - Jan activity is RCPP. New format quantified in reaching targeted audience of N. Hawaiians and Pacific Islanders is relationships. Mailers sent to the residents of area. Saturday, January 28, 2023, 9am noon is the event Gifts from the Āina: Ohana Experience. Community activities include pounding poi, Native Hawaiian carver talking about relationship with the forest, living garden with Hawaiian foods will have a make-n-take food box with recipe, and a hands-on experience. Talk story with people as exposed to farm bill programs.

#### ii. 2022 Farm Bill:

- CSP Renewals 2018 5 signed up but only 2 funded. Other 3 can sign up for regular CSP announcement will be made in February.
- EQIP about 40 applications and moving through eligibility.
- TSP draft allocation is subject to change \$1million
- Locally led pool \$255,000
- Others bills and funding coming...
- Soil Health Management Plans on hold while Soil Health team is reviewing.
