

HCP -Species of Concern







<u>nēnē - Hawaiian Goose</u>

<u>'ua'u - Hawaiian Petrel</u>






Blackburn's Sphinx Moth








Site Visit Schedule

Required Safety Gear

Wind Farm

- Long pants/sleeved shirt
- Closed-toed/sturdy shoes
- Safety glasses/goggles
- Hard hat (outside O&M vicinity)

Pu'u Makua

- Long pants/sleeved shirt
- Closed-toed shoes







Safety Awareness

- Uneven walking terrain
 - Stay on the roads and paths
 - Closed-toed sturdy shoes
- Objects moving/working above
 - Hard hats on at all times
 - Stay with the tour group
- Traveling on dirt roads
 - 4X4 wheel vehicle
 - Travel with experienced driver
- Heat/cold stress
 - Take breaks!
 - Water and electrolytes are available



Rules of Conduct

- Treat others respectfully
- Be professional
- Obey all safety signs
- Site speed limit is 15mph
- Smoking is only allowed in designated areas
- If something looks unsafe it probably is...IF YOU ARE IN DOUBT...ASK!
