- The Draft Kaua'i Seabird HCP (KSHCP) has been developed to address light attraction impacts on Kaua'i to three seabird species protected under State and Federal endangered species laws: the Hawaiian Petrel (*Pterodroma sandwichensis*), the Newell's Shearwater (*Puffinus auricularis newelli*), and the Band-rumped Storm-petrel (*Oceanodroma castro*). The Draft KSHCP also addresses the impacts of lights on the Central North Pacific distinct population segment of the listed Green Sea Turtle (*Chelonia mydas*).
