- Tawhiri Power, LLC requests a 20-year Incidental Take License for the Pakini Nui Wind Farm on the island of Hawai'i to permit incidental take of the Hawaiian Hoary Bat (*Lasiurus cinereus semotus*), the Hawaiian Petrel (*Pterodroma sandwichensis*), and the Hawaiian Goose or Nēnē (*Branta sandvicensis*). Submitted is the September 2019 Draft HCP for final recommendation by the ESRC.
- ITEM 4.** ESRC vote to recommend to the Department and Board of Land and Natural Resources to approve, amend, or reject the Pakini Nui Wind Farm Draft HCP
- ITEM 5.** Draft Kaua'i Seabird HCP and Participant Inclusion Plans (PIPs): Agency Staff Presentation and Request for Comments
- The Draft Kaua'i Seabird HCP (KSHCP) has been developed to address light attraction impacts on Kaua'i to three seabird species protected under State and Federal endangered species laws: the Hawaiian Petrel (*Pterodroma sandwichensis*), the Newell's Shearwater (*Puffinus auricularis newelli*), and the Band-rumped Storm-petrel (*Oceanodroma castro*). The Draft KSHCP also addresses the impacts of lights on the Central North Pacific distinct population segment of the listed Green Sea Turtle (*Chelonia mydas*).
- The Draft HCP and PIPs are again presented for ESRC and public consideration and comments.
