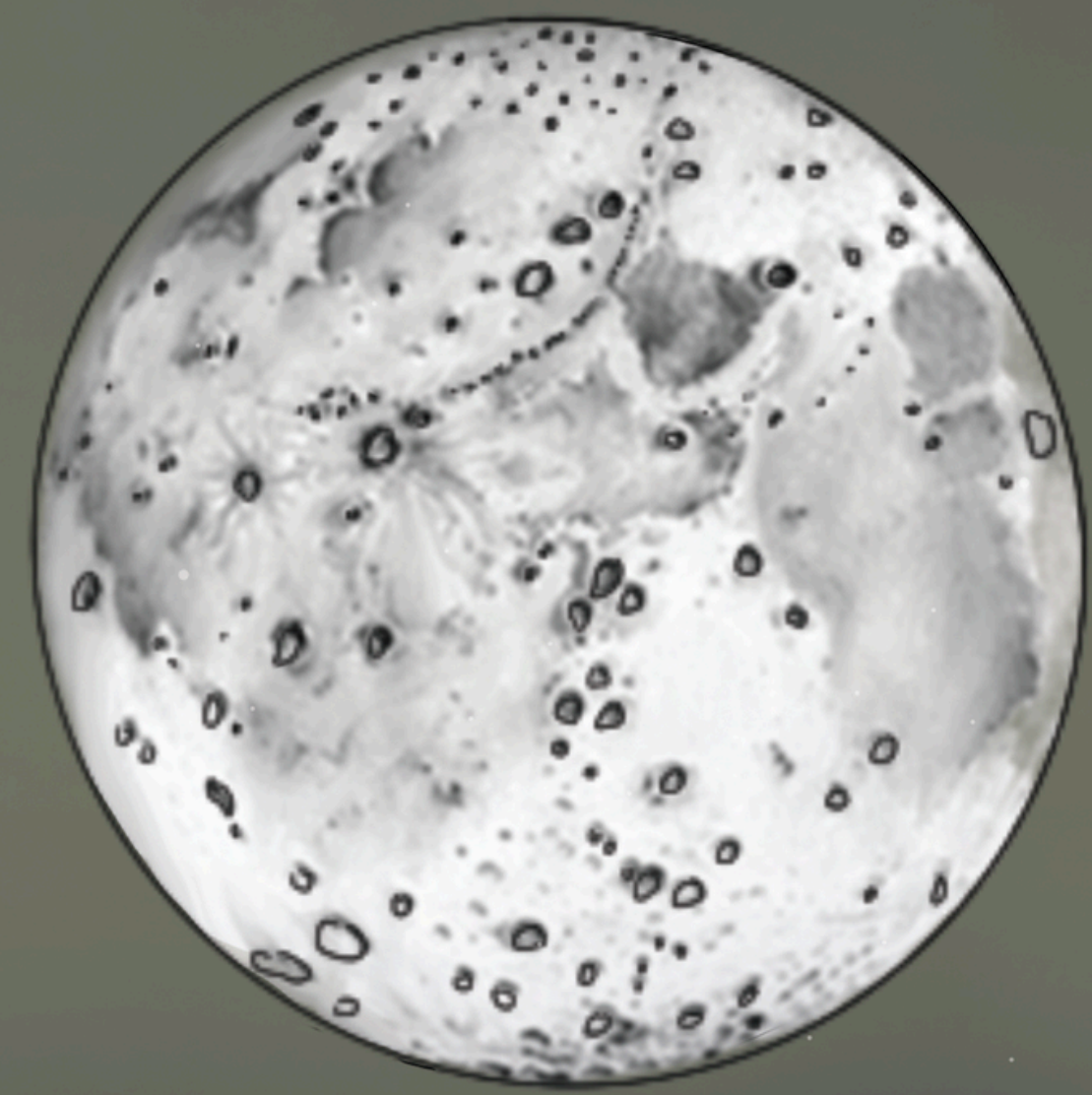


TURN DOWN THE LIGHTS TURN UP THEIR CHANCES

Grounded and unable to take off, they face deadly threats without rescue. Demand better lighting policies and dim your lights at night to help seabirds reach the ocean.
