

## STATUS ON THE ADOPTION OF RULES PERTAINING TO OPERATING THRILL CRAFTS TO CONDUCT OCEAN CLEANUP

#### **PURPOSE**

This report complies with Section 3 of Act 118, 2013, Session Laws of Hawaii 2013, requiring the Department of Land and Natural Resources (Department) to report on the status of adopting rules to allow thrill crafts to be used to conduct ocean cleanup activities and requires a report to be submitted no later than twenty days prior to the convening of the 2014 Regular Session.

### **ACTIONS**

The Department's Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation (DOBOR), met with several individuals regarding the process of amending, repealing, and compiling the Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) as they apply to thrill craft. DOBOR is working with the individuals on drafting HAR amendments and once they are finalized will begin the process to amend the HAR.
