**Declare Project Exempt From Requirements of Chapter 343, HRS, and Title 11,  
Chapter 200, Hawaii Administrative Rules  
Installation of Vessel Sewage Pump-Out Stations, Statewide  
Various Boating Facilities, Hawaii**

The Board of Land & Natural Resources approved the award of the construction contract for the subject project on July 12, 2013. Pursuant to Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), and Chapter 11-200, Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), the attached Exemption Notification labeled Exhibit A was prepared.

The Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation (DOBOR) is proposing to install marine vessel sewage pump-out stations and supporting facilities at various boating facilities throughout the state.


In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8(A) and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources (DLNR), approved by the Environmental Council, on June 5, 2015, this project is exempt from the preparation of an Environmental Assessment (EA) pursuant to the following exemptions:

Scope of Work: Installation of marine vessel sewage pump-out stations and supporting facilities.  
Exemption Class No. 3, Item No. 12: Installation of marine vessel sewage pump-out stations and supporting facilities.

Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed project as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, these projects will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
