REMARKS: Clean Islands Council, Inc. currently has a 20-foot container at Kalaeloa Barbers Point Harbor under Revocable Permit No. H-94-1842, for the storage of a boat and oil spill cleaning equipment. The Council requests an additional 12,000 square feet to store marine oil spill response equipment. The Harbors Division has no objections to the subject request.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation, Harbors Division to issue the applicant a revocable permit for the above stated purpose, subject to the terms and conditions outlined above and incorporated herein by reference, and such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation.



