REQUEST:

Issuance of a revocable permit for equipment parking, ramp office, ticket counter and ground service equipment parking to United Airlines, Inc. at Līhu'e Airport ("LIH").

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

Pursuant to Section 11-200-8(a), Environmental Impact Statement Rules of the Department of Health, State of Hawaii, this disposition is exempt from requirements regarding preparation of an environmental assessment, negative declaration, or environmental impact statement as required by Chapter 343, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended, relating to Environmental Impact Statements, because the proposed action falls within Exemption Class #1, Comprehensive Exemption List for the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, dated November 15, 2000, as approved by the Environmental Quality Council. Exemption Class #1 covers operations, repairs, or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing.

The DOTA consulted with the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration as to the appropriateness of the citation of the Environmental Exemption Class from the Comprehensive list for the Department of Transportation dated November 15, 2000. In this case, the FAA concurred on the appropriateness.

REMARKS:

The Department of Transportation (DOT) has no objections to UA's request. DOT is working to implement dispositions of the Līhu'e terminal ramp area in order to optimize revenue for the State and ensure the safe operation of the ramp area therefore, in accordance with Sections 171-11 and 171-55, HRS, relating to Public Purposes and Permits, respectively, and therefore, the DOT proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to UA for Area/Space Nos. 610-107, 610-188L, 640-133B,640-109D, and Bldg/Room Nos. 306-105A, 306-105B, 306-105D, 306-105F, 306-107A, 306-107B, 306-114A, 306-124, 306-125, 306-212B, 306-213, 306-223A, 306-223B, 306-223C for ticket counter, curbside check-in, baggage claim offices, GSE storage and ramp office at Līhu'e Airport.
