Issuance of Right-of-Entry Permit to Maui Interscholastic League, for Event Operations Purposes Related to the 2018 Maui Interscholastic League Surf Contest, at Hamoa, Hana, Maui, Tax Map Key (2) 1-4-007: Portion of 009.

APPLICANT:

Maui Interscholastic League (MIL), a domestic non-profit corporation.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Section 171-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes, as amended.

LOCATION:

Portion of Government lands situated at Koki Beach, Hamoa, Hana, Maui, identified by Tax Map Key (2) 1-4-007:009 por., as shown on the attached map labeled Exhibit A.

AREA:

Total: 300 square feet, more or less

300 sq. ft. (three 10x10 judges' tents)

ZONING:

State Land Use District: Conservation

TRUST LAND STATUS:

Section 5(b) lands of the Hawaii Admission Act

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Unencumbered

CHARACTER OF USE:

For setting up three event tents.

TERM OF RIGHT-OF-ENTRY:

One day event scheduled for Saturday, March 31, 2018 from 5:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

CONSIDERATION:

Total Cost: \$30.00 (one-time payment based on \$.10 per square foot per day).
Area of requested use 300 sq. ft. x \$.10 = \$30.00 per day
\$30.00 x 1 days of use = \$30.00

CHAPTER 343 - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 11-200-8 and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources approved by the Environmental Council and dated June 5, 2015, the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No. 1, that states "Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing" and Item No. 51, that states "Permits, licenses, registrations, and right-of-entry issued by the Department that are routine in nature, involving negligible impacts beyond that previously existing." APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS:

Applicant shall be required to:

- 1) Provide traffic control to assure that Haneoo Road remains clear and traffic through the area is unobstructed;
- 2) Contact the Hana Police Department to inform them of the date and time of the scheduled event along with a traffic control plan;
- 3) Obtain required permits from the DLNR Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation for the ocean water portions of this event; and
- 4) Upon completion of the event the area shall be cleaned and all temporary structures removed in their entirety.


REMARKS:

The Maui Interscholastic League (MIL) has requested the use of 300 square feet of Koki Beach in Hamoa, Hana, Maui for the annual Maui Interscholastic League Surf Contest. This event has been held annually for at least twenty-two years, and at Koki Beach for the past three years. Applicant has requested use of 300 square feet of government lands for three 10'x10' pop-up tents for the judges. The entire event, from set-up to clean-up, will take place on March 31, 2018, from 5:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m.

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board


1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
2. Authorize the issuance of a right-of-entry permit to Maui Interscholastic League for this year's surfing contest.
 - A. The standard terms and conditions of the most current right-of-entry permit form, as may be amended from time to time; and
 - B. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.

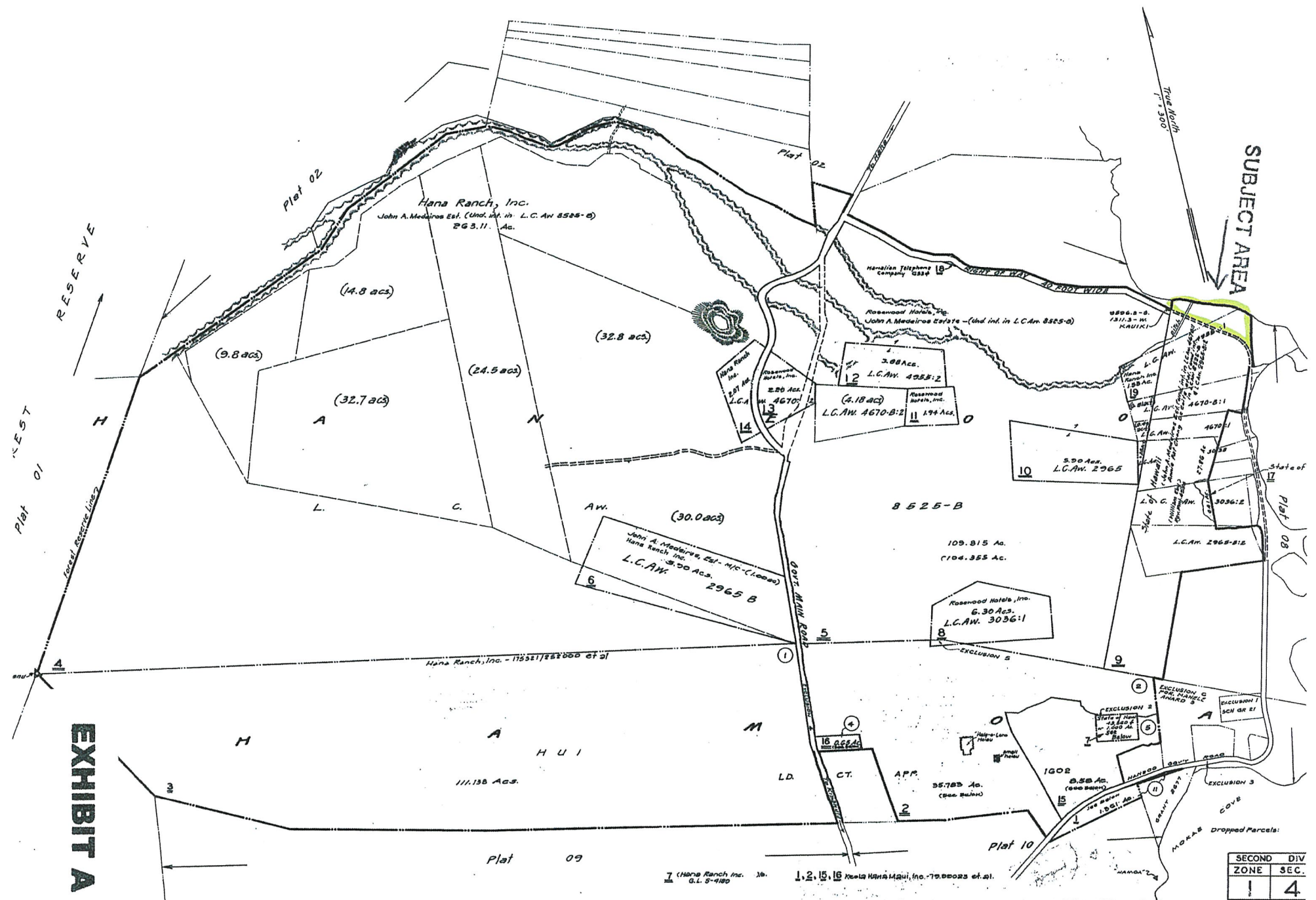

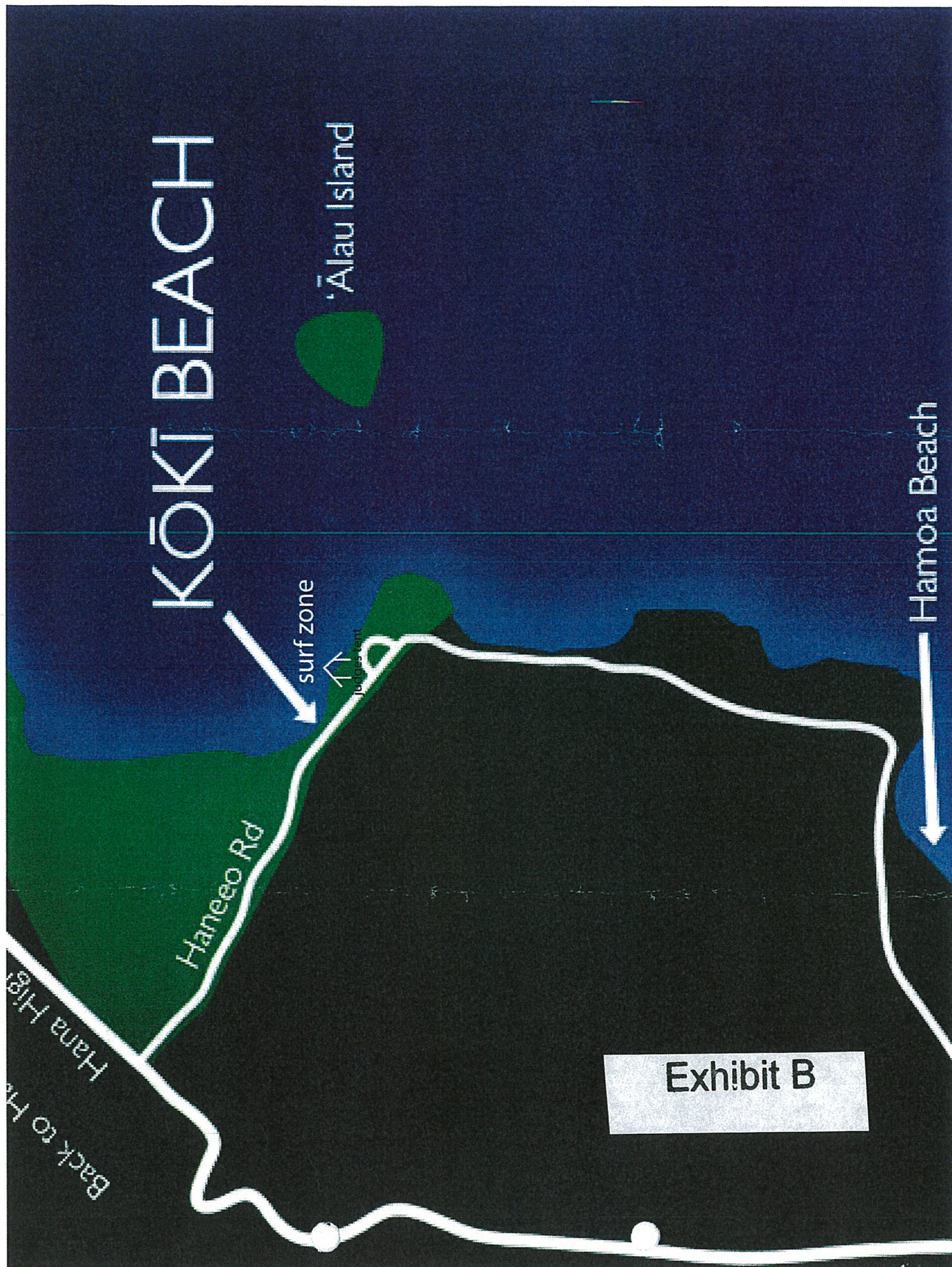
