## REPORT ON THE INSTANCE OF USAGE OF ELECTRIC GUNS

This report is submitted in accordance with Section 134-16(d), Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), regarding the maintenance of records and instance of usage of electric guns.

The Department of Land and Natural Resources' (Department) Conservation and Resources Enforcement Program has not yet met the law enforcement accreditation standards of the Commission on Accreditation for Law Enforcement Agencies, Inc., in the use of electric guns, as mandated by Section 134-16(f), HRS. Nor for that matter, does the Department expect to meet those law enforcement accreditation standards in the immediate future. Consequently, the Department has not obtained any electric guns or related equipment and reports no instances of use.
