ISSUANCE OF A LEASE FOR OFFICE SPACE AND A PARKING STALL UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, FEDERAL AVIATION ADMINISTRATION DANIEL K. INOUYE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT TAX MAP KEY: (1) 1-1-003: 058 (PORTION) O'AHU

APPLICANT:

United States of America (USA) by the Federal Aviation Administration (FAA).

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Section 171-95, Hawai'i Revised Statutes (HRS).

LOCATION:

Building No. 344, Ewa Domestic Extension, Second Level and Parking Facilities, Operational Ramp Areas, Ground Level at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, identified by Tax Map Key: 1st Division, 1-1-003: 058 (Portion).

<u>AREA</u>:

Building/Room No. 344-274A, containing an area of approximately 364 square feet; and Parking Space No. 612-102B, as shown and delineated on the attached maps labeled Exhibits A and B.

State Land Use District:

Urban

City and County of Honolulu LUO:

Industrial (I-2)

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LAND TITLE STATUS:

Section 5(a) lands of the Hawai'i Admission Act: Non-Ceded

DHHL 30% entitlement lands pursuant to Hawai'i Admission Act YES NO X

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3201, dated June 8, 1983, setting aside 3,152.177 acres designated as Daniel K. Inouye International Airport under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (DOTA) for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Operations office and FAA vehicle parking to be utilized by the United States FAA Office of Hazardous Materials Safety, Systems Oversight Field Operations Branch for their daily operations at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport.

LEASE TERM:

Five (5) Years, commencing October 1, 2018, to and including September 30, 2023.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$12,523.20 per annum (as determined from the DOTA schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide plus \$655.20 for electricity and \$1,092.00 for air conditioning), payable in monthly installments of \$1,043.60 per month.

PERFORMANCE BOND:

Not Applicable

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

Pursuant to Section 11-200-8(a), Environmental Impact Statement Rules of the Department of Health, State of Hawai'i, this disposition is exempt from requirements regarding preparation of an environmental assessment, negative declaration, or environmental impact statement as required by Chapter 343, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, as amended, relating to Environmental Impact Statements, because the proposed action falls within Exemption Class #1, Comprehensive Exemption List for the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, dated November 15, 2000, as approved by the Environmental Quality Council. Exemption Class #1 covers operations, repairs, or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing.

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The DOTA consulted with the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration as to the appropriateness of the citation of the Environmental Exemption Class from the Comprehensive list for the Department of Transportation dated November 15, 2000. The FAA concurred on the appropriateness.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-95, HRS, relating generally to <u>Public Lands</u>, <u>Management and Disposition of</u> and relating specifically to <u>Disposition to Governments</u>, <u>Governmental Agencies</u>, <u>Public Utilities</u>, and <u>Renewable Energy Producers</u>, Airports Division proposes to issue a lease to the FAA for an operations office and FAA vehicle parking to be utilized by the United States FAA Office of Hazardous Materials Safety, Systems Oversight Field Operations Branch.

The present State Lease No. DOT-A-13-0008 (FAA Lease No. DTFAWN-13-L-00135) issued to the United States of America, acting by and through the Contracting Officer of the Federal Aviation Administration, Western-Pacific Region, on behalf of the United States FAA Office of Hazardous Materials Safety, Systems Oversight Field Operations Branch, will expire on September 30, 2018. The FAA is requesting issuance of a new lease to replace the lease that will be expiring.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a lease to the FAA, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State; and (3) review and approval of the Department of the Attorney General as to the lease form and content.
