Authorizing the Department of Transportation (DOT) to Dispose of Interstate Highway I-H1-1(93) fka Federal Aid Project No. F-59 (2), Land Court Lot 38-A, Tax Map Key: (1) 2-8-09:030 (por.)

REQUEST:

Authorization to dispose of subject parcel, designated as Lot 38-A on the attached Land Court map, and also TMK: (1) 2-8-09:030 (por.) on the attached Tax Map Key Map. This request is being made at the request of the abutting land owner of TMK (1) 2-8-009:037 to correct an inadvertent encroachment issue with the owner's house onto State land.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Section 171-52 and other applicable sections of Chapter 171, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), as amended.

LOCATION:

The parcel is located on the Island of Oahu.

AREA:

Interstate Highway: 1,406 square feet.

ZONING:

TMK: (1) 2-8-09:030 (por.) (Oahu) is zoned as "R-5".

LAND TITLE STATUS:

Ceded, DHHL 30% entitlement lands pursuant to the Hawaii State Constitution:

YES ____ NO <u>X</u>

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Lot 38-A is an unused remnant acquired during the construction of the Interstate Highway. The Lot is surplus to the State Department of Transportation's needs. Lot 38-A was a vacant lot; however, the abutting owner inadvertently built a dwelling and concrete pad over a portion of Lot 38-A and wishes to purchase the property rather than remove the encroachment.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon transfer of title to the abutting owner.

COMPENSATION:

Remnant is to be disposed of in compliance with section HRS 171-52.

LIENS AND/OR ENCUMBRANCES:

Restrictive Covenants within Document 4392, Transfer Certificate of Title No 46,416 which recites in part:

"AND the said Grantee, ... COVENANTS with the said Grantor as follows:


That no malt, vinous, spirituous or intoxicating liquors of any kind shall ever be sold or exposed for sale or manufactured on the granted premises or any part thereof."


CHAPTER 343 – ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

Not applicable. Parcel was part of roadway and will become privately owned land upon transfer. Chapter 343, HRS, would not apply to any future development on the parcel as no State lands would be involved.

REMARKS:

The parcel was deemed surplus to the DOT's needs. The DOT has no objection to the disposal and transfer to an abutting property owner as prescribed by the Director in the best interest of the State of Hawaii.





RECOMMENDATION:

Authorize the DOT to dispose of Interstate Highway I-H1-1(93) fka Federal Aid Project F-59 (2), Tax Map Key: (1) 2-8-009:030 (por.), Land Court Lot 38-A in compliance with section 171-52 and any reimbursement of the Federal Aid Project, in accordance with Hawaii Revised Statutes, subject to the following:

- 1. The property will be conveyed to the owner thru Quitclaim Deed;
- 2. Review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General;
- 3. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State;
- 4. The parcel shall be sold at fair market value to be determined by a licensed appraiser, chosen by the State of Hawaii;
- 5. The parcel shall be conveyed in an "as is" condition and the State makes no warranty or representation about its condition or the presence of hazardous materials on, under or about the same.
