to be 10 feet in length, thus unauthorized harvest of bamboo, guava or other species will be enforced on a \$0.20 per linear foot basis.

<sup>3</sup> Cuttings and fruits of non-native species or common native species, including but not limited to pine boughs or cones, flowers, lei making materials, seeds, and fruits.

Commercial applicants are not eligible for any quantity of resources free of charge.
