Request to Write-Off Uncollectible Account on the Island of Oahu. Wallace K. Lean III, Revocable Permit No. S-7814 Owing \$199.71

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Section 40-82, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the directors, boards, or executive heads of executive departments may from time to time prepare and submit for review of the Attorney General a list of all uncollectible accounts in their departments. Such accounts as the Attorney general finds to be uncollectible shall be entered in a special record and be deleted from the accounts receivable records of the departments, which shall thereupon be relieved from any further accountability for their collection.

The following balance have been deemed uncollectible:

RP 7814 Wallace K. Lean, III

 Kalauao, Ewa, Oahu

Amount owing: \$199.71

This is a revocable permit for general agriculture purposes that commenced on March 1, 2012 and terminated on February 1, 2015.

The Land Board at its meeting of December 12, 2014, under agenda item D-29, terminated Revocable Permit No. S-7814 for failure to keep rental payments current and keep the premises in a clean, sanitary and orderly condition.

Upon termination, the security deposit was applied to the delinquent rent and staff had attempted to collect the balance owed with no results. The February 3, 2016 Star Advertiser's Obituary Notices included a notice that Mr. Lean had died January 16, 2016.


RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board approve of and recommend to the Attorney General that the above listed uncollectible account be deleted from the Department of Land and Natural Resources accounts receivable and placed in a special record and that, should any account so listed become collectible, that such account be transferred back to the current accounts receivable.
