TO ADD STORAGE SPACE

PURPOSE:

To amend the existing Concession Agreement No. DOT-A-08-0011 at the Daniel K. Inouye International Airport to add storage space. Under Article III (Premises) of the Agreement, the specific area assigned or provided for the concession activity may be changed at the discretion of the Director of Transportation.

Area/Space No. 355-121, containing an area of approximately 143 square feet, as delineated on the attached map labeled Exhibit B-30 dated April 2019.

IMPROVEMENTS:

Applicant at its own cost and expense shall be responsible for any renovation, upgrade, remodeling and improvements to the additional space.

RENTAL:

The annual sum of \$2,488.20 (as determined from the DOTA schedule rates and charges established by appraisal of Airport's property statewide).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

Pursuant to Section 11-200-8(a), Environmental Impact Statement Rules of the Department of Health, State of Hawai'i, this disposition is exempt from requirements regarding preparation of an environmental assessment, negative declaration, or environmental impact statement as required by Chapter 343, Hawai'i Revised Statutes, as amended, relating to Environmental Impact Statements because the proposed action falls within Exemption Class #1, Comprehensive Exemption List for the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, amended November 15, 2000, as approved by the Environmental Quality Council. Exemption Class #1 covers operations, repairs, or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing.

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The DOTA consulted with the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration as to the appropriateness of the citation of the Environmental Exemption Class from the Comprehensive list for the Department of Transportation dated November 15, 2000. The FAA concurred on the appropriateness.

REMARKS:

The Department of Transportation and Smarte Carte entered into that certain Concession Agreement No. DOT-A-08-0011, dated August 21, 2008, for the Luggage Cart and Baggage Locker Concession at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport. The requested storage space is integral to Smarte Carte's luggage cart and baggage locker rentals operation at the Airport.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board approve and authorize the addition of storage space as hereinabove outlined, subject to: 1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; 2) such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State; and 3) review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General.
