DECLARE PROJECT EXEMPT FROM REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 343,
HRS AND TITLE 11, CHAPTER 200, HAWAII ADMINISTRATIVE RULES.

Sections 171-55 Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), as amended.

LOCATION:

Portion of Government lands situated at Kikiaola Small Boat Harbor, Kekaha, Island of Kauai,
Hawaii, Tax Map Key: (4) 1-2-006:017 (Portion), hereinafter referred to as the "Premises" as
shown on the map labeled **(EXHIBIT A1 & A2)** and attached hereto.

AREA:

Approximate 380 square feet, more or less.

ZONING:

State Land Use District: Conservation, Urban
County of Kauai: Open, Conservation

TRUST LAND STATUS:

Section 5(b) lands of the Hawaii Admission Act:

DHHL 30% entitlement lands pursuant to the Hawaii State Constitution: NO X YES

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Encumbered by Miscellaneous Permit # KMP-002 – issued to The Hungry Menehune, LLC.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Mobile food wagon selling plate style lunches, chips and soft drinks.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

The first day of the month to be determined by the Chairperson, with an expiration date of June 30, 2020.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

Two hundred dollars (\$200.00) per month or ten percent (10%) of gross receipts, whichever is greater.

COLLATERAL SECURITY DEPOSIT:

Twice the Monthly Rental.

CHAPTER 343 – ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

In accordance with the “Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources”, reviewed and concurred upon by the Environmental Council on June 5, 2015, the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to Exemption Class No

1, Item No. 51, Permits, licenses, registrations, and rights-of-entry issued by the Department that are routine in nature, involving negligible impacts beyond that previously existing.

REMARKS:

Applicant currently occupies approximately 380 square feet of unimproved state land at the Kikiaola Small Boat Harbor under a miscellaneous permit. Staff has determined that the miscellaneous permit is not the correct disposition for this use and is therefore requesting the issuance of a revocable permit. The applicant's proposed use is allowed under County of Kauai zoning. **(EXHIBIT B1)**

The applicant has not had a lease, permit, easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the last five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

Staff consulted and received concurrence from the Kauai District Land Office on the exemption confirmation.

JUSTIFICATION:

The issuance of revocable permit is a short-term measure which will allow staff to test the market to determine if it's practicable to seek the issuance of concession contract for a food truck at this location

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Land and Natural Resources:


1. Declare that, after considering the potential effects of the proposed project as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.
2. Authorize the issuance of Revocable Permit to The Hungry Menehune, LLC. covering the subject area for a mobile food concession under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference, incorporated herein and further subject to the following:
 - a. The standard terms and conditions of the most current Revocable Permit form, as may be amended from time to time; and
 - b. Review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General.
 - c. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.

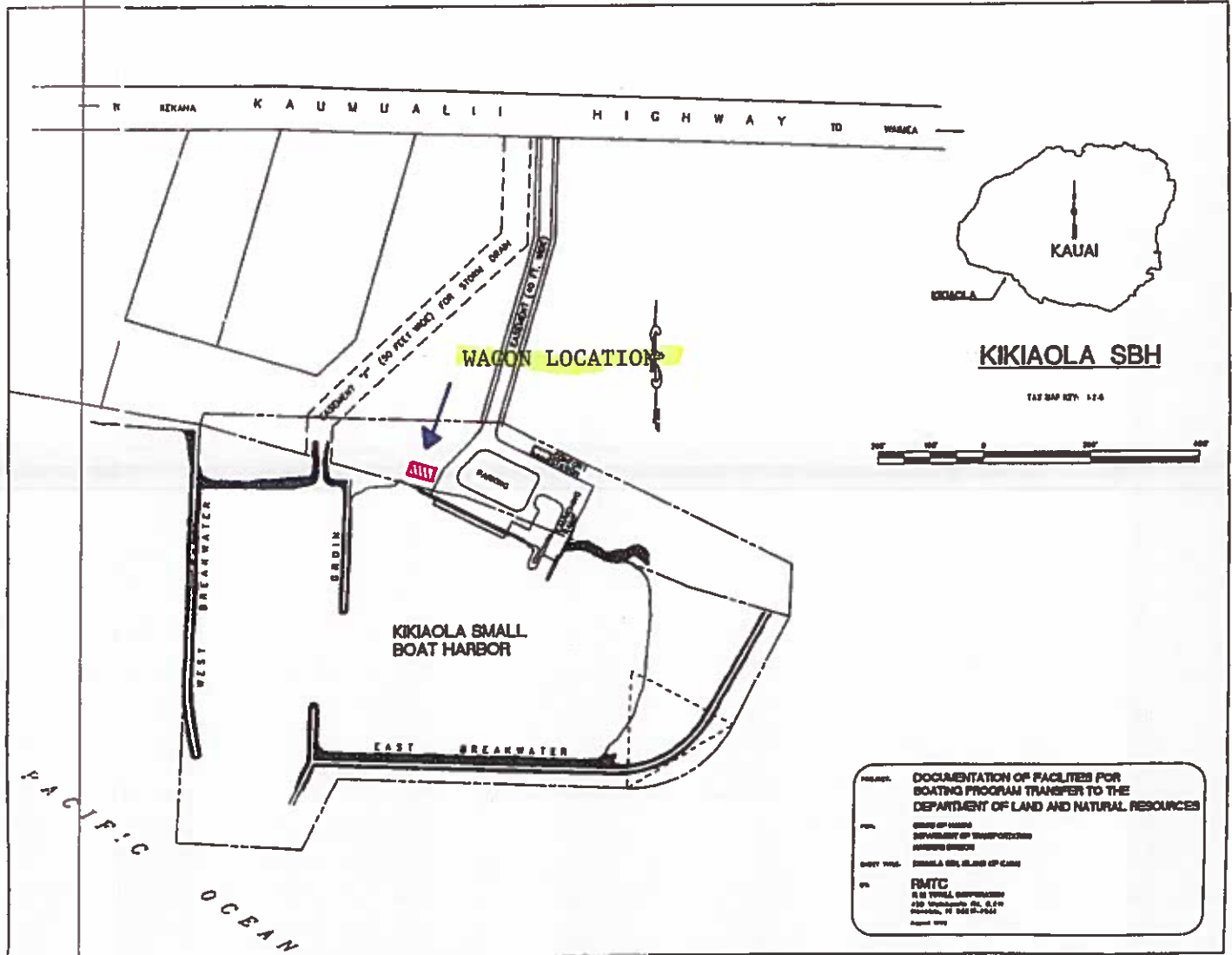
