ISSUANCE OF A REVOCABLE PERMIT FOR FIELD OFFICE/STORAGE SPACE HAWAII UNIFIED INDUSTRIES, LLC DANIEL K. INOUYE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Portion of Building No. 360, Ewa Concourse, Ground Level at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Island of Oʻahu, State of Hawaiʻi, identified by Tax Map Key: 1st Division, 1-1-003: 066 (Portion).

AREA:

Building/Room No. 360-190C, containing an area of approximately 120 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached map labeled Exhibit "A".

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3201, dated June 8, 1983, setting aside 3,152.177 acres designated as Daniel K. Inouye International Airport under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division ("DOTA") for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Hawaii Unified will use the space for a field office/storage space for State Project No. BO1934-43, Maintenance and Repair of Motorized Doors, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Honolulu, Hawai'i.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$25.00 (as stated in Item No. 10.13 Provisions for Field Office/Storage Space in the Specifications and Proposal for Maintenance and Repair of Motorized Doors, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Honolulu, Hawai'i, State Project No. BO1934-43).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

Pursuant to Section 11-200-8(a), Environmental Impact Statement Rules of the Department of Health, State of Hawai'i, this disposition is exempt from requirements regarding preparation of an environmental assessment, negative declaration, or environmental impact statement as required by Chapter 343, HRS, as amended, relating

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to Environmental Impact Statements, because the proposed action falls within Exemption Class #1, Comprehensive Exemption List for the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, dated November 15, 2000, as approved by the Environmental Quality Council. Exemption Class #1 covers operations, repairs, or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing.

The DOTA consulted with the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) as to the appropriateness of the citation of the Environmental Exemption Class from the Comprehensive list for the Department of Transportation dated November 15, 2000. The FAA concurred on the appropriateness.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Hawaii Unified Industries for a field office/storage space for State Project No. BO1934-43, Maintenance and Repair of Motorized Doors, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Honolulu, Hawai'i.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Hawaii Unified, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
