DECLARE PROJECT EXEMPT FROM REQUIREMENTS OF CHAPTER 343, HRS AND TITLE 11, CHAPTER 200.1, HAWAII

ADMINISTRATIVE RULES.

APPLICANT:

Atlantis Submarine Hawaii, LLC, a Delaware limited liability company, whose mailing address is 75-5660 Palani Rd. #304, Kailua-Kona, Hawaii 96740-1673.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Sections 171-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), as amended.

LOCATION:

Portion of Government lands situated at Honokohau Small Boat Harbor (HSBH), Honokohau, North Kona, Island of Hawaii, Hawaii identified by Tax Map Key: (3) 7-4-008:003 (por.) as shown on the attached map labeled **Exhibits A and B**.

AREA:

Approximate measurement of 60' x 55' or 3,300 Square Feet, hereinafter referred to as the "Premises".

The area consists of four small structures and a shipping container shown on **Exhibit B**. There is also a private driveway to the structures. All of Atlantis Submarine's structures and the drive way are within the permit area.

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Currently Encumbered by Revocable Permit (RP) 36.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Occupy and use the Premises for the following specified purposes only: Maritime related activities to support submarine tour operations.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

February 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2020.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

Three Thousand One Hundred Eighty-Two and 70/100 dollars (\$3,182.70) per month, payable in advance by the first of each and every month and for the period beginning February 1, 2020, and ending June 30, 2020.

The proposed rent was increased by applying a three percent (3%) escalation, as recommended in the appraisal, done by CBRE, dated October 31, 2016, on behalf of DLNR DOBOR, to the 2019 rent of Three Thousand Ninety and no/100 dollars (\$3,090.00) per month.

COLLATERAL SECURITY DEPOSIT:

Twice the Monthly Rental Amount.

CHAPTER 343 – ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

This Exemption Notice for the above action is based on general exemption types enumerated in HAR § 11-200.1, under Exemption Class, 1. Operations, repairs, or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features, involving, minor expansion or minor change of use beyond that previously existing.

Also, under DLNR Exemption List reviewed and concurred to by the Environmental Council on June 5, 2015, Exemption List Class 1: Item 51, "Permits, licenses, registrations and rights-of-entry issued by the Department that are routine in nature, involving negligible impacts beyond that previously existing".

In consultation with the Hawaii Land Division, regarding HRS Chapter 343, they concurred that this RP met the requirements of Chapter 343, HRS, and chapter 11-200.1, HAR and this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment.

REMARKS:

At its February 8, 2019, meeting, under agenda Item J-2, the Board approved the continuation of RP 36 issued to Atlantis Submarine Hawaii, LLC in effect from February 1, 2019, to January 31, 2020.

Atlantis Submarine Hawaii, LLC has not had a lease, easement, or other disposition of state lands terminated within the last five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

JUSTIFICATION FOR AN RP:

Staff is working on converting this RP to a long-term disposition. The process of converting this RP to a long-term disposition will require additional time. Therefore, an RP is the proper disposition at this time.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Land and Natural Resources:

- 1. Declare that after considering the potential effects of the proposed disposition as provided by Chapter 343, HRS, and Chapter 11-200.1, HAR, this project will probably have minimal or no significant effect on the environment and is therefore exempt from preparation of an environmental assessment.
- 2. Authorize the continuance of Revocable Permit 36 issued to Atlantis Submarine Hawaii, LLC at Honokohau Small Boat Harbor covering the subject area for submarine tour operations under the terms and conditions cited above, which are by this reference, incorporated herein.

3. Reserve and delegate to the Chairperson the right and authority at any time to review and adjust the rental charges for Atlantis Submarine Hawaii, LLC.




