I am respectfully requesting that this lease either be denied or at least deferred.

As a long-time Kauai resident, these are my concerns:

-- Churches already enjoy non-profit status making their acquisition of land easier than businesses or private citizens on Kauai. Why would they need a forty-year lease at only \$1 per year?

-- This is prime oceanfront property in Kapaa. No competing community groups have been allowed to submit proposals for other potential community uses for the same site. Why has there been no transparent public outreach process on determining use for this parcel?

-- All of Kapaa, and Kauai in general, have a lack of public parking for businesses, tourists, etc. There's also a large homeless population that hasn't been addressed with affordable housing. Why does a church get preferential treatment in a country that prides itself on separation of church and state?

-- Additionally, while I am certain there are fine community members associated with New Hope, their belief systems and potential prejudices are not apparent on their publicly-facing websites. The associated executive order states, " This venue will be utilized for weddings, funerals, first birthday celebrations, as a counseling center, and for other community purposes...." Can we say for certain that these "community purposes" would be free of discrimination as required by Hawaii law?

-- Additionally, a review of all of New Hope's publicly-facing information shows that they are currently Lihue-based-- an outreach center on Umi Street and services at the Kauai Veterans Center. When we are still completing the Lihue and Rice Street revitalization process, why would a Lihue-based organization be moving to Kapaa? Perhaps I misunderstand and this is just an extension to Kapaa of their Lihue congregation but some information on this would be helpful.

By no means am I stating that eventually New Hope may prove the ideal tenant of the available parcel, but without clarity on why this sweetheart deal was granted and what other community opportunity costs are being lost with that location, this action should be deferred or denied at this time.

I would like to express my opposition to the proposed lease of the property at 1326 Inia Street in Kapa`a between the County of Kaua`i and New Hope Church.

First I am concerned that the proposed lease seems to have been negotiated without giving other parties, besides the Church, an opportunity to suggest alternative uses. This is not the way our government should work!!

Second, it is not clear what skills and experience the Church would provide to deal with the issues that it claims it will deal with in the area: homelessness and drug use. The area in question, next to a county park, close to homes and a preschool and adjacent to numerous restaurants and businesses, is not the place for such activity. It will only invite more homeless and addicted folks into the area and make conditions there worse.

Third there is a serious need for additional parking in the area and the property in question would be ideal for the creation of such parking. I understand that the Kapa`a Business Association has been asking for such parking for a number of years and had hoped to make use of this property for that purpose, but were ignored when the decision was made by County officials to lease the property to New Hope. (Worse, if my understanding is correct, they were not even informed that the lease was contemplated!)

A parking lot in this area will not only serve the needs of Kapa`a businesses but will also serve the general public who use both the park and the nearby bike and pedestrian path. I hope you will deny the lease to New Hope Church and look out for the needs of the larger public in Kapa`a.

My name is Aaron Rosenstiel, I am a resident of Kapaa and I support this acquisition. I have been attending New Hope Kauai since March, 2016 at its current location in the Kapaa High School cafeteria. New Hope Kauai has helped me to develop myself as a Christian and better myself in many ways. The service they provide to the community is of extreme importance, not only to myself, but for the many members that attend the church as well as community members that do not attend the church, but are assisted in other ways.

It is my understanding that the current plan is for a multiuse facility that will not only serve as a location for regular Sunday church services, but also for a variety of uses that will help support the community and improve our island such as providing a venue for weddings, funerals, first birthdays, etc. as well as a location for a local police presence and a counselling center. This is a very good reason in itself for the church to be permitted to acquire this property for their new facility so that they can provide more services for the community.

In addition, while I have enjoyed going to New Hope Kauai for many years in its current location, it would be beneficial for the members of New Hope Kauai to have facility primarily for church services to improve the quality of services and relieve some of the burden on church members who have to setup for church services in the school cafeteria each week.

Currently several church members have to come early on Saturday morning and move tables out of the center of the cafeteria and setup chairs for everyone attending church as well as reset the cafeteria at the end of each service. It would be a huge benefit to these members to have a sanctuary that was already setup so that they do not have to do this each Saturday and Sunday.

I personally volunteer in the Children's Ark ministry and help take care of the children on Sunday and I see a need here as well for the children attending church to have more space and Sunday school classrooms that are already setup for this purpose rather than classrooms that have to be converted each Sunday. Currently we are limited to a small area in the classroom because we have to move desks and chairs to make room for our activities, plus we have to take out and put away our learning aids and toys each Sunday rather than having them all setup already in an organized fashion in the classroom. I'm sure there are many other members of the church that would benefit from having a larger, dedicated space as well, such as hospitality having a dedicated kitchen area, small groups having meeting rooms and our worship team having a set stage and a place to rehearse each week; as well as others I may not have considered.

In summary granting New Hope Kauai the acquisition of the property in question would allow the church to reach out and assist more members of the community by providing them with services that are not currently available on the east side and also help to improve our church services and relieve some of the burden on our dedicated church members that setup for church each week. Any lease holder given the unique opportunity to occupy this State/BLNR/County property should offer a guarantee that they can and will provide for ALL in the community without bias, coercion or discrimination.

At this time we ask that you DENY the signing of this lease until ALL in the Kapaa community have the opportunity to review and understand what is at stake. At this time there are MANY who question the process or are in opposition to this lease agreement, not just ONE in opposition as is stated in the existing lease agreement.

How is it that 737 in the Kapaa community have declared their support when VERY FEW in the Kapaa community were even made aware of this opportunity at a PUBLIC Meeting and with complete transparency?

Please defer and or deny this lease until the entire Kapaa community can be apprized of this situation and have the opportunity to offer their individual views and proposals to provide for community needs and social services.

The Wailua-Kapaa Neighborhood Association (W-KNA) is opposed to granting the above referenced Lease. We understand that by Executive Order No. 4566, the state has set aside a .521-acre property for the county, identified for "community needs and social services related purposes" to be under the control and management of the County. However, we want to inform you that, at no time, did the county reach out to other community or faith-based organizations (other than New Hope Church) for proposals.

Although Mayor Derek Kawakami belatedly met with representatives from Kapa'a Business Association, the Royal Coconut Coast Association, and W-KNA on February 5, 2020 (months after the initial request) the following concerns remain unresolved:

- a) The 700+ project supporters who signed a petition and wrote letters only represent the New Hope congregation, and not the broader community.
- b) There are no measurable objectives in the lease agreement to help ensure that the lessee fulfills the required "community needs and social services related purposes." Spiritual guidance "counseling" does not meet this stated goal.
- c) To remedy the omission of a public outreach process and lack of transparency, BLNR can require the county to provide opportunity for community input and proposals.
- d) Any proposed land use must not exacerbate the existing parking and traffic issues. If these lots were designated for public parking instead, the traffic congestion caused by vehicles maneuvering to parallel park along Kuhio Highway and circling in search of parking spaces would be mitigated.
- e) The long-standing need for public parking is identified in the Draft East Kauai Community Plan 2035 as a "critical issue". There is insufficient parking for Kapa'a restaurants and businesses, for events and sporting activities held at Kapa'a Beach Park, and for the coastal multi-use path.
- f) The county has failed to comply with BLNR's mandate for demolition of the seaward building.
- g) Relinquishing this public land for the next 40-years at \$1.00/year is wrong and significantly out-of-step with current DLNR lease rents.

W-KNA respectfully requests that the board defer or deny the Lease and instruct the county to explore other options in a transparent manner that engages broad community input.
