LEGAL REFERENCE:

Sections 171-6, 171-13, 171-17, 171-55, and 171-59, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), as amended.

APPLICANT:

Petrospect, Inc. (Applicant) is a domestic profit corporation whose mailing address is 499 North Nimitz Highway, Pier 21, Honolulu, Hawaii 96817.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Container storage of petroleum product inspection equipment.

LOCATION:

Portion of governmental lands at Pier 21, Honolulu Harbor, Oahu, Tax Map Key No. (1) 1-5-039:007 (P), Governor's Executive Order No. 2903, as shown on the attached map labeled Exhibit A.

Determined by appraisal as of April 1, 2019, for Revocable Permits in Honolulu Harbor.

TRUST LAND STATUS:

Land acquired after statehood, Subsection 5(a) of the Hawaii Admission Act (non-ceded land).

CURRENT USE STATUS:

The Applicant currently has an existing month-to-month permit that occupies a portion of Pier 21, Honolulu Harbor, Oahu for container storage of petroleum product inspection equipment. The Department of Transportation, Harbors Division (DOT Harbors), has been reviewing all month-to-month permits to ensure compliance with and applicability to Sections 171-17 and 171-55, HRS. The DOT Harbors is updating the Applicant's permit with current appraised rates and updated permit terms (as applicable).

LAND TITLE STATUS:

Acquired by the DOT Harbors, through eminent domain proceedings by issuance of Governor's Executive Order No. 2903.

CHAPTER 343 - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

This action is exempt from Office of Environmental Quality Control (OEQC) requirements pursuant to Sub-Chapter 11-200.1, Hawaii Administrative Rules, that exempts the following:

"Exemption Class 1: Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing."

The DOT Harbors will submit its publication request of this Exemption Notice to the OEQC for publication on the 8th of each month.

REMARKS:

The Applicant has been providing independent petroleum inspection services in Hawaii since 1985. The Applicant conducts inspections, documentation, and reconciliation of marine transfers of crude oils and petroleum products.

Currently the Applicant has an existing month-to-month permit to support its petroleum product inspection company. The DOT Harbors has been reviewing all month-to-month permits to ensure compliance with and applicability to Sections 171-17 and 171-55, HRS.

The existing month-to-month permit was issued on December 1, 2012, and rent is currently \$80.00 per month. This Submittal will update and renew the month-to-month permit which is compliant with Chapter 171, HRS.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the DOT Harbors to issue the Applicant a month-to-month revocable permit for the above-stated purposes, subject to the terms and conditions outlined above and incorporated herein by reference, and such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
