CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3201, dated June 8, 1983, setting aside 3,152.177 acres designated as Daniel K. Inouye International Airport under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (DOTA) for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Asia Pacific Airlines will use the space for parking of ground service equipment as part of their Non-Signatory Airline Carrier Operations at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$1,056.08, based upon a rate of \$6.67 per square foot per annum for paved, ramp area open equipment parking, as determined from the DOTA schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide.

Environmental Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1011-033. The EA is a joint State and Federal document, dated September 1989 and published in the October 23, 1989 issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, relevant mitigation from the EA and DOT-A environmental best management practice will address minimal impacts from this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Asia Pacific Airlines for parking of ground service equipment, as part of their Non-Signatory Airline Carrier Operations at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Asia Pacific Airlines, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
