CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area is covered by the Honolulu International Airport, Airport Modernization Program Environmental Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1030-13. The EA is a joint State and Federal document dated, January 2013, and published in the February 8, 2013 issue of the OEOC

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Bulletin. Accordingly, the actions have been determined to have little or no impact upon the environment.

REMARKS:

The Department of Transportation proposes to issue a permit to Hensel Phelps Construction Co. for the use of the spaces for vehicle parking and construction staging area, free of rent, as specifically stated under Contract No. 65065, State Project No. AO1123-30, HNL NDWP IIT Mauka Extension, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Honolulu, Hawai'i. Section 1.04 — Provisions for Field Office/Storage Space: "Pending the availability of space on airport property, the State will issue a permit to the Contractor for the use of the space, at no charge, to be used specifically for a field office and/or storage of materials and equipment...."

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Hensel Phelps Construction Co., subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
