LAND TITLE STATUS:

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3074, dated August 20, 1981, setting aside 4,204.10 acres designated as KOA under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

TSA will use the office and breakroom space for administration purposes.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon complete execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$2,540.00 (\$1,750.00, as determined from the DOTA schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide, plus \$250.00 for air conditioning, \$390.00 for utilities and \$150.00 for maintenance).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (HDOT-A), has determined that the environmental impacts of the subject land area and use is covered by the Kona International Airport at Keāhole Final Environmental Assessment (FEA), published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control (OEQC) in the March 23, 2013, issue of The Environmental Notice. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the FEA and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to TSA, for the use of an office and breakroom space for administration purposes at Ellison Onizuka Kona International Airport at Keāhole.

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RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to TSA, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
