ISSUANCE OF A REVOCABLE PERMIT FOR A CONTRACTOR OFFICE TRAILER PARKING AREA, MATERIAL STORAGE CONTAINER STAGING AREA AND REFUSE DUMPSTER STAGING AREA NAN, INC.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

APPLICANT:

Nan, Inc., whose mailing address is 636 Laumaka Street, Honolulu, Hawai'i 96819.

LOCATION:

A portion of Staging Area, Diamond Head Service, Court Area at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Island of Oʻahu, State of Hawaiʻi, identified by Tax Map Key: 1st Division, 1-1-003: 001 (Portion).

AREA:

Area/Space No. 001-123, containing an area of approximately 14,778 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached Exhibit A.

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3201, dated June 8, 1983, setting aside 3,152.177 acres designated as Daniel K. Inouye International Airport under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division ("DOTA") for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Nan, Inc. will use the spaces for a contractor office trailer parking area, material storage container staging area and refuse dumpster staging area, as specifically stated under Contract No. 67055, State Project No. AO1033-23, HNL Ticket Lobby Renovations and BHS Improvements, Phase 2, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Honolulu, Hawai'i.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

To be determined by the Director of Transportation at a later date.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$25.00 (as stated in Contract No. 67055, State Project No. AO1033-23, HNL Ticket Lobby Renovations and BHS Improvements, Phase 2, at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport).

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

\$75.00 or three (3) times the monthly rental in effect.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area are covered by the Honolulu International Airport, Airport Modernization Program Environmental

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Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1030-13. The EA is a joint State and Federal document dated, January 2013, and published in the February 8, 2013 issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, the actions have been determined to have little or no impact upon the environment.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to Permits, the DOTA proposes to issue a permit to Nan, Inc. for the use of the spaces for a contractor office trailer parking area, material storage container staging area, equipment staging area and refuse dumpster staging area, as specifically stated in Contract No. 67055, State Project No. AO1033-23, HNL Ticket Lobby Renovations and BHS Improvements, Phase 2, at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Section 1.4, Field Office: "Pending the availability of space on airport property, the State will issue a permit to the CONTRACTOR for the use of the space, to be used specifically for a field office. The CONTRACTOR will be charged \$25 (Twenty-Five Dollars) per month under a revocable permit, which shall be considered to be part of the CONTRACTOR's overhead costs. The State at its option may also provide a construction trailer..."

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Nan, Inc., subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
