# APPLICANT:

Flying Food Group, LLC (Flying Foods), whose business address is 324 Rodgers Boulevard, Suite C, Honolulu, Hawai'i 96819.

# CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division, has determined that the minimal impacts of this action is exempt, pursuant to Hawai'i Administrative Rules, Section 11-200.1-15 (c)(8); the impacts of administratively transferring an existing lease to a revocable permit are de minimis.

The subject land area and building are covered by the Crash Fire Rescue Building Negative Declaration, published in the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) October 23, 1977 issue of the EQC Bulletin.

# **REMARKS:**

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Flying Foods for an airline flight kitchen facility as part of its in-flight catering operations at KOA.

# **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Flying Foods, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
