CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 931 issued in 1941 to the Superintendent of Public Works for public purposes as Port Allen Airport. Under the Government Reorganization Act of 1959, the Department of Public Works was transferred to the Department of Transportation.

CHARACTER OF USE:

L3Harris will use the space for the installation of ADS-B radio equipment and an antenna to support the operation of the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration Air Traffic Control Tower at PAK.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$21.38 (based on a rate of \$0.75 for improved, paved land, as determined from the Airports Division Schedule of Rates and Charges for Airport properties statewide).

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CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division has determined that the impacts of this action are de minimis and exempt, pursuant to <u>Department of Transportation</u>, Comprehensive Exemption List, Type 8, Part 1, 8(h), concurred to by the Environmental Advisory Council on February 1, 2022.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to L3Harris for the installation of ADS-B radio equipment and an antenna to support the operation of the U.S. Federal Aviation Administration at PAK.

RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to L3Harris, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
