#### LAND TITLE STATUS:

### **CURRENT USE STATUS:**

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3074, dated August 20, 1981, setting aside 4,204.10 acres designated as KOA under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division for Airport Purposes.

## **CHARACTER OF USE:**

HKA will use the ramp space to store parts, consumables, and equipment, in support of its aviation aircraft maintenance operation at KOA.

### **COMMENCEMENT DATE:**

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

### **MONTHLY RENTAL:**

\$90.13 (based on a rate of \$2.06 per square foot per annum for improved, paved land, as determined from the DOTA schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide).

### **SECURITY DEPOSIT:**

\$270.39, or three (3) times the monthly rental in effect.

## CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division, has determined that the subject land area and use is covered by the Keahole Airport General Aviation and Maintenance Baseyard Facilities Negative Declaration, published by the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) in the December 23, 1980, issue of the EQC Bulletin. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the Negative Declaration and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.
