LAND TITLE STATUS:

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 1611, dated February 1, 1954, setting aside 10.321 acres, being a portion of Moloka'i Airport under the control and management of the Hawaii Aeronautics Commission (subsequently transferred to the Department of Transportation) for Public Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

MAC will use the booth to inform residents and visitors about their organization by providing brochures and posting class schedules/workshops, to support their non-profit arts education organization on Moloka'i.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$88.20 (as determined from the Airports Division Schedule of Rates and Charges for Airport properties statewide).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (HDOT-A), has determined that the subject areas are covered by the Moloka'i Airport Improvements Environmental Assessment (EA), published by the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) in the December 23, 1981 issue of the EQC Bulletin. Accordingly, all relevant

mitigation from the EA and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to MAC for booth space, which will be used to inform residents and visitors about their organization by providing brochures and posting class schedules/workshops, to support their non-profit arts education organization on Moloka'i.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to MAC, including its conditions and rent, will serve ethe best interests of the State.
