CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3201, dated June 8, 1983, setting aside 3,152.177 acres designated as Daniel K. Inouye International Airport under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (DOTA) for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Hawaiian Airlines, Inc., will use the spaces for staging and storage of construction material and equipment for the Terminal 1 U.S. Transportation Security Administration Security Checkpoint Relocation Project in Lobby 3.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area are covered by the Honolulu International airport Master Plan Update and Noise Compatibility Program Environmental Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1011-033. The EA is a joint State

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and Federal document, dated September 1989 and published in the October 23, 1989 issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, relevant mitigation from the EA and DOTA environmental best management practice will address minimal impacts from this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55 HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Hawaiian Airlines, Inc., for staging and storing of construction material and equipment for Terminal 1 for the U.S. Transportation Security Administration Security Checkpoints in Lobby 3.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on the submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to Hawaiian Airlines, Inc., including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
