#### **CURRENT USE STATUS:**

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 4614, dated October 28, 2019, setting aside 883.583 acres designated as Līhu'e Airport to be under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation for Airport Purposes.

#### **CHARACTER OF USE:**

Hawaiian Airlines will use the ramp space for two (2) mobile office/storage trailers and to park ground service equipment, as part of its Signatory Airline Carrier Operations at the Airport.

# CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division, has determined that the environmental impacts of the proposed tenant lease for the subject land use is covered by the Lihue Airport Master Plan Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), published by the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) in the August 8, 1976, and August 23, 1976, issues of EQC Bulletin and accepted by the Governor on April 26, 1977. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the EIS and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

#### **REMARKS**:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Hawaiian Airlines for ramp space for two (2) mobile office/storage trailers and to park ground service equipment, as part of its Signatory Airline Carrier Operations at the Airport.

#### RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board authorize the Department of Transportation to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Hawaiian Airlines, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State.
