CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 4614, dated October 28, 2019, setting aside 883.583 acres designated as Līhu'e Airport to be under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

G2 will use the space for a passenger service counter and storage space to support its porter service operations under contract with multiple airline carriers at LIH.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$332.64 (\$233.10 as determined from the Department of Transportation, Airports Division schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide plus \$49.14 for utilities, \$31.50 for air conditioning and \$18.90 for maintenance).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division, has determined that the environmental impacts of the proposed tenant use for the subject

land use is covered by the Līhu'e Airport Master Plan Environmental Impact Statement, published by the Environmental Quality Commission (EQC) in the August 8, 1976 and August 23, 1976, issues of EQC Bulletin and accepted by the Governor on April 26, 1977. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the EIS and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to G2 for a passenger service counter and storage space to support its porter service operations under contract with multiple airline carriers at LIH.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to G2, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
