APPLICANT:

Ralph S. Inouye Co., Ltd., whose mailing address is 500 Alakawa Street, Suite 220E, Honolulu, Hawai'i 96817.

LOCATION:

Building No. 360, Ewa Concourse, Ground Level, and a portion of Ewa Service Road at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Island of O'ahu, State of Hawai'i, identified by Tax Map Key: 1st Division, 1-1-003: 066 (Portion) and 1-1-003: 068 (Portion).

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3201, dated June 8, 1983, setting aside 3,152.177 acres designated as Daniel K. Inouye International Airport under the control and management of the State of Hawai'i, Department of Transportation, Airports Division ("DOTA") for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Ralph S. Inouye Co., Ltd. will use the spaces for a construction staging area for equipment, and materials and field office, as specifically stated under State Project No. AO1043-30, Replace the Overseas Terminal Roof at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Honolulu, Hawai'i.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area are covered by the Honolulu International Airport, Airport Modernization Program Environmental BLNR- ISSUANCE OF A REVOCABLE PERMIT FOR A CONSTRUCTION STAGING AREA FOR EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS AND FIELD OFFICE RALPH S. INOUYE CO., LTD. Page 3

Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1030-13. The EA is a joint State and Federal document dated, January 2013, and published in the February 8, 2013 issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, the actions have been determined to have little or no impact upon the environment.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the DOTA proposes to issue a permit to Ralph S. Inouye Co., Ltd. for the use of the space for a construction staging area for equipment and materials and field office, as specifically stated in contract for State Project No. AO1043-30, Replace the Overseas Terminal Roof at HNL, Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Section 1.04, <u>Provisions for Field Office/Storage Space</u>: "Pending the availability of space on airport property, the State will issue a permit to the Contractor for the use of the space, assessed at a monthly fee of \$25 for each Revocable Permit issued."

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to Ralph S. Inouye Co., Ltd., including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
