LEGAL REFERENCE:

Section 171-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), as amended.

APPLICANT:

Air Canada, whose mailing address is 7373 Cote Vertu West, Saint Laurent, Quebec H4S 1Z3, Canada.

LOCATION AND TAX MAP KEY:

Portion of Ellison Onizuka Kona International Airport at Keahole (KOA), Kailua-Kona, Island of Hawaii, identified by Tax Map Key: 3rd Division, 7-3-43: Portion of 003.

AREA:

Building/Room No. 344-105, containing an area of approximately 110 square feet, as shown and delineated on the attached Exhibit A.

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3074, dated August 20, 1981, setting aside 4,204.10 acres designated as KOA under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division for airport purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Air Canada will use the space for an airline ticket office in support of its Signatory Airline Carrier Operation at KOA.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$158.40 (\$99.00 as determined from comparable Old ARFF Building No. 347 and the DOTA schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide, plus \$42.90 for utilities and \$16.50 for maintenance).

SECURITY DEPOSIT:

\$475.20, or three (3) times the monthly rental in effect.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division, has determined that the subject land areas are covered by the Keahole Airport Master Plan Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control (OEQC) in the November 8, 1988, issue of The Environmental Notice and accepted by the Governor on December 19, 1988. Accordingly, all relevant

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mitigation from the EIS and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Air Canada for an airline ticket office in support of its Signatory Airline Carrier Operation at KOA.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to Air Canada, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
