LEGAL REFERENCE:

Section 171-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), as amended.

APPLICANT:

Air Canada, whose mailing address is 7373 Cote Vertu West, Saint Laurent, Quebec H4S 1Z3, Canada.

LOCATION AND TAX MAP KEY:

CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3074, dated August 20, 1981, setting aside 4,204.10 acres designated as KOA under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

Air Canada will use the space for a shed to store airline supplies and passenger luggage in support of its Signatory Airline Carrier Operation at KOA.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$25.00 (based on the minimum rental charge as determined from the Department of Transportation, Airports Division Schedule of Rates and Charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide. The calculation using the improved, paved land rate of \$2.06 per square foot per annum is less than the minimum rental charge).

<u>CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:</u>

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division (DOTA), has determined the subject land areas are covered by the Final Environmental Assessment (EA)/Finding of No Significant Impact (FONSI), Airfield, Terminal, and Facility

Improvements for the Kona International Airport at Keahole, published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control (OEQC) in the March 23, 2013, issue of The Environmental Notice. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the EA and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to Air Canada for space for a shed to store airline supplies and passenger luggage in support of its Signatory Airline Carrier Operation at KOA.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month revocable permit to Air Canada, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
