# **LOCATION AND TAX MAP KEY:**

# **CURRENT USE STATUS:**

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 2653, dated March 5, 1973, setting aside 284.466 acres designated as General Lyman Field under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division for public purposes.

# **CHARACTER OF USE:**

GSA/TSA will use the spaces for administrative purposes as offices, training and breakrooms, and storage to support the Transportation Security Administration's (TSA) operations at ITO.

# TERM OF LEASE:

Three (3) years.

### **COMMENCEMENT DATE:**

Upon execution of the Lease.

### **ANNUAL RENTAL:**

\$43,184.40 per annum (\$28,938.00, as determined from the DOTA schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide, plus \$8,681.404 for utilities and \$5,565.00 for air conditioning).

# CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports Division, has determined that the environmental impacts of the subject land area and use is covered by the General Lyman Field, New Passenger Terminal, Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS), published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control (OEQC) in the October 17, 1973, issue of EIS Newsletter. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the FEIS and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

# **REMARKS**:

In accordance with Sections 171-59 (b), and other applicable sections of Chapter 171 HRS, as amended, relating generally to Management and Disposition of Public Lands, and relating specifically to the Disposition by Negotiation, the Department of Transportation (DOT) proposes to issue a directly negotiated lease to GSA/TSA for the purpose of offices, training and breakrooms, and storage spaces to support TSA operations at ITO.

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

That the Board authorize the DOT to issue a directly negotiated lease to GSA/TSA, subject to: (1) terms and conditions herein outlined, which are by reference incorporated herein; and (2) such additional terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Director of Transportation to best serve the interests of the State; and (3) review and approval of the Department of the Attorney General as to the lease form and content.
