## **CURRENT USE STATUS:**

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 2653, dated March 5, 1973, setting aside 284.466 acres designated as General Lyman Field under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports for public purposes.

G2 will use Space No. 306-148 to store baggage carts to support its airline passenger assistance operation at ITO.

#### CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports, has determined that the environmental impacts of the subject land area and use is covered by the General Lyman Field, New Passenger Terminal, Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS),

published by the Office of Environmental Quality Control (OEQC) in the October 17, 1973, issue of EIS Newsletter. Accordingly, all relevant mitigation from the FEIS and best management practices will be implemented to address the minimum impacts of this action.

## **REMARKS:**

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation (DOT) proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to G2 for storage of baggage carts and a passenger assistance desk to support its airline passenger assistance operation at ITO.

#### **RECOMMENDATION:**

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the DOT recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to G2, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
