CURRENT USE STATUS:

Land presently encumbered by Governor's Executive Order No. 3074, dated August 20, 1981, setting aside 4,204.10 acres designated as KOA under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation, Airports for Airport Purposes.

CHARACTER OF USE:

CFI will use the spaces for storage and processing of perishable freight shipped to and from local customers from airlines and air cargo operators as part of its cargo forwarding operation at KOA.

COMMENCEMENT DATE:

Upon complete execution of the revocable permit.

MONTHLY RENTAL:

\$3,600.64 (\$2,509.12 as determined from the Department of Transportation, Airports schedule of rates and charges established by appraisal of Airports property statewide, plus \$790.92 for utilities and \$300.60 for maintenance).

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The subject land area pertaining to this action was evaluated for environmental impact by the Keahole Airport Master Plan Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), published in The Environmental Notice on November 8, 1988, and accepted by the Governor on

December 19, 1988. This action is consistent with the 1988 EIS and the same mitigation conditions apply.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to <u>Permits</u>, the Department of Transportation proposes to issue a month-to-month revocable permit to CFI for storage and processing of perishable freight shipped to and from local customers from airlines and air cargo operators as part of its cargo forwarding operations at KOA.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to CFI, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.
