REQUEST:

Issuance of a Revocable Permit for a field office and vehicle parking for passenger loading bridge maintenance project at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport.

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Section 171-55, Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS).

APPLICANT:

Bowers + Kubota Consulting, Inc., whose mailing address is 94-408 Akoki Street, Waipahu, Hawaii 96797.

LOCATION AND TAX MAP KEY:

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CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area are covered by the Honolulu International Airport, Airport Modernization Program Environmental Assessment (EA), State Project No. AO1030-13. The EA is a joint State and Federal document dated January 2013, and published in the February 8, 2013 issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, the actions have been determined to have little or no impact upon the environment.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to Permits, the DOTA proposes to issue a permit to Bowers + Kubota Consulting, Inc for a field office and vehicle parking, as specifically stated in Contract No. 70780, State Project No. BS1224-18 Construction Management Services for Passenger Loading Bridge Maintenance, Statewide Airports, 1.6 Field Office: “Pending the availability of space on airport property, the STATE may issue a Revocable Permit (RP) to the CONTRACTOR for the use of the space, assessed at the nominal monthly fee specified for the respective airport for each Revocable Permit issued. The space(s) shall be used only for a field office, and subject to the approval of the State, vehicle parking may be allowed.”

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to Bowers and Kubota Consulting, Inc., including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.



