Transportation, Airports (DOTA) for Airport Purposes.

Transportation System at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport.

CHAPTER 343, HRS - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

The environmental impacts of the proposed action to the subject land area are covered by
the Honolulu International Airport Final Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), State
Project No. AO1011-03. The EIS is a joint State and Federal document, dated April 1991
and published in the May 23, 1991, issue of the OEQC Bulletin. Accordingly, relevant

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mitigation from the EIS and DOTA environmental best management practice will address minimal impacts from this action.

REMARKS:

In accordance with Section 171-55, HRS, relating to Permits, the DOTA proposes to issue a permit to SPEEDI for facilities designated by the Airport to operate, maintain and manage the Intra-Airport Passenger Transportation System (Wiki Wiki Shuttle), as specifically stated under Contract No. 70729, State Project No. EO1009-23, Specifications and Proposal for Operation, Maintenance and Management of the Intra-Airport Passenger Transportation System at Daniel K. Inouye International Airport, Section 10.3.B.7. – Use of Equipment and Facilities – “All operating facilities and equipment furnished by the State will be at no rental cost to the Contractor.”

SPEEDI was awarded the contract to provide transportation for airline passengers, the general public and employees within the Airport property 24 hours per day, seven days per week utilizing State Fleet of owned and/or leased vehicles.

RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, and testimony and facts presented, the Department of Transportation recommends the Board finds that approving the issuance of a month-to-month Revocable Permit to SPEEDI, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interests of the State.

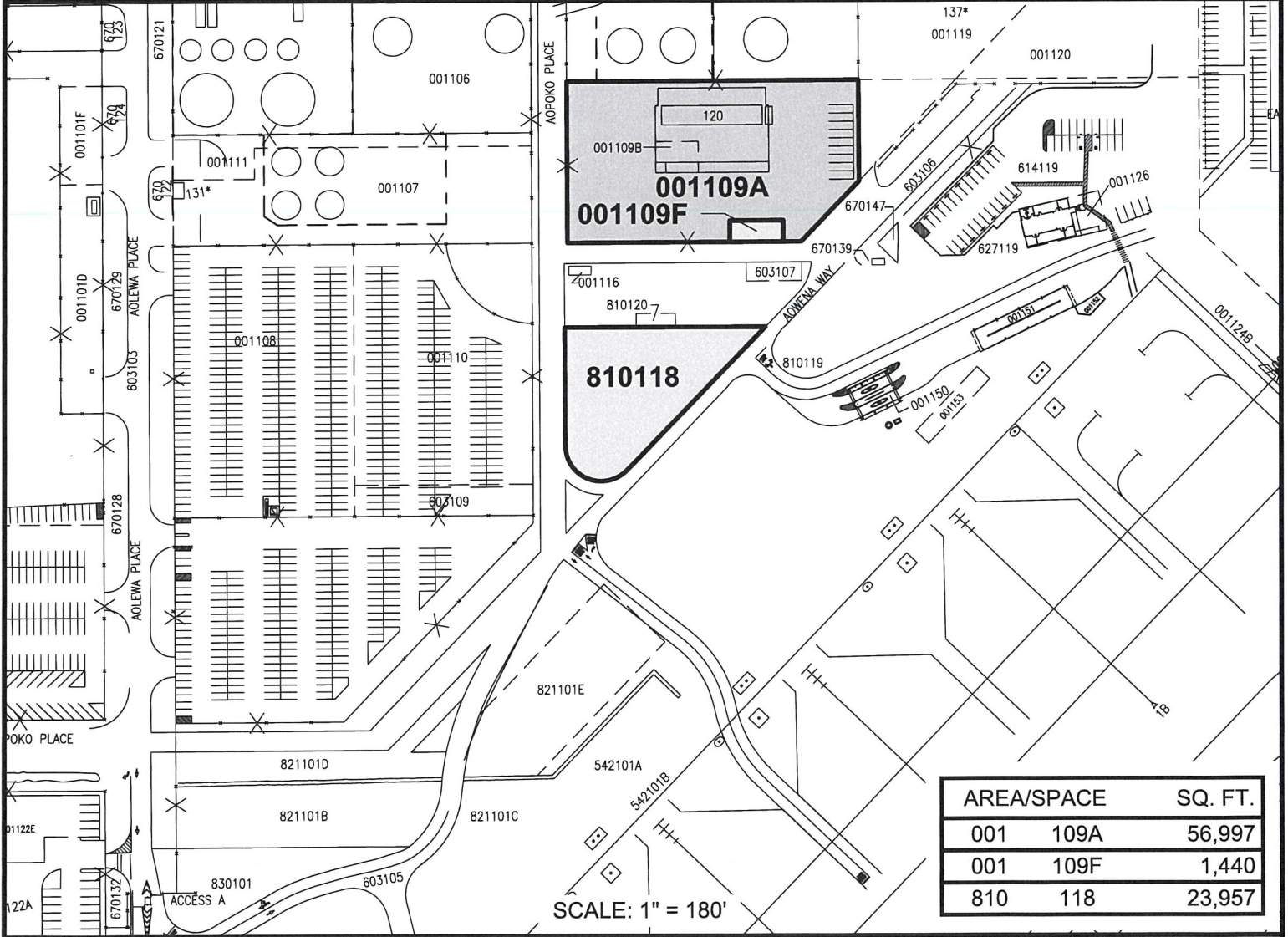
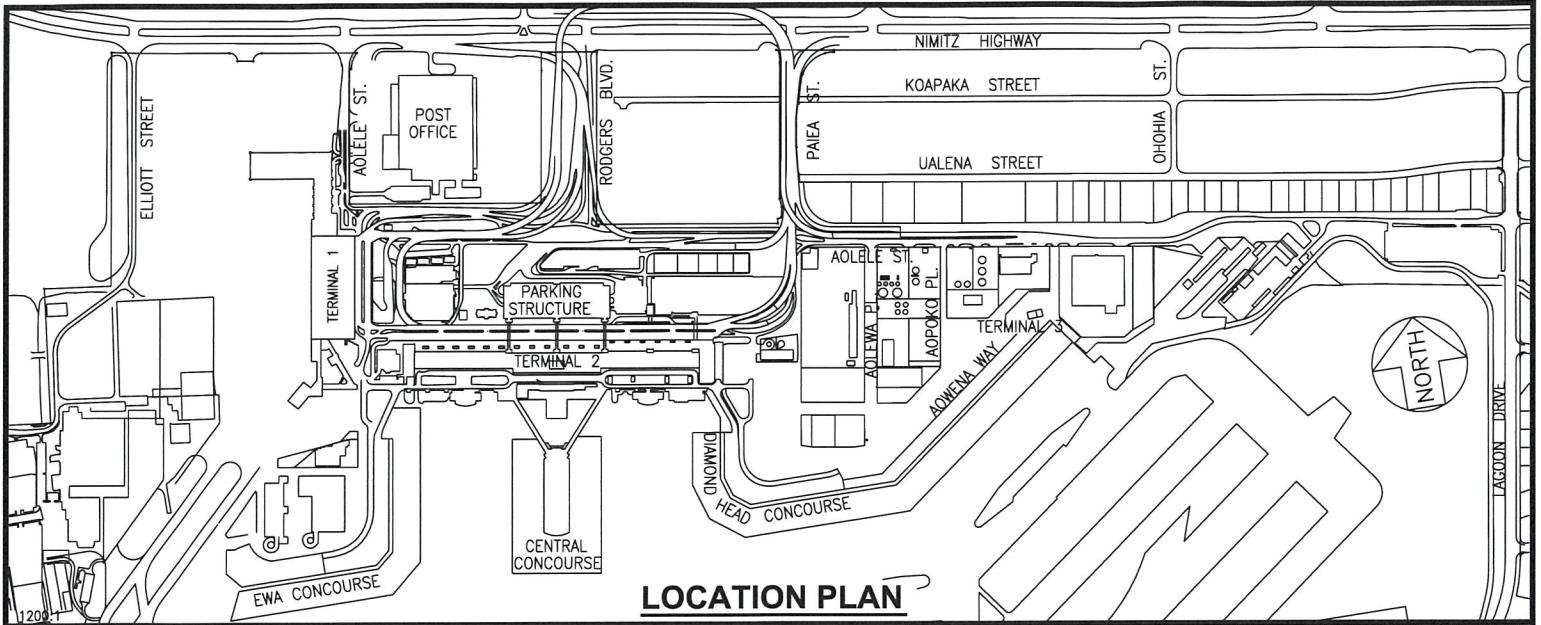
