In accordance with Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) § 11-200.1-15 and the Exemption List for the Department of Land and Natural Resources reviewed and concurred on by the Environmental Council on November 10, 2020, the subject request is exempt from the preparation of an environmental assessment pursuant to General Exemption Type 1 that states, "Operations, repairs or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment, or topographical features, involving minor expansion or minor change of use beyond that previously existing," and Part 1, Item 44 that states, "Permits, licenses, registrations, and rights-of-entry issued by the Department that are routine in nature, involving negligible impacts beyond that previously existing." REMARKS:

University of Hawaii for the benefit of the University of Hawaii at Manoa, Department of Intercollegiate Athletics (UH) will be holding a collegiate Beach Volleyball Tournament. The tournament will be held at Kalapaki Beach, Kauai on November 17-19, 2023 from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm. Setup will begin at 7:00 am and breakdown will be completed by 6:00 pm daily. Six volleyball courts will be set up on State land for the duration of the permit. UH will be very sensitive to the beach and will be returning the beach to its pristine condition which includes doing a rubbish sweep daily.

UH states that no spectator seating will be placed on the beach/State land by event coordinators and no sponsorship signs will be posted anywhere in the immediate area. UH further states that there will be no commercial activity taking place on the State's land.

Since this is a state (UH) to state (DLNR) situation, both entities are self-insured by the State insurance program.

Applicant has not had a lease, permit, easement or other disposition of State lands terminated within the past five years due to non-compliance with such terms and conditions.

The proposed activity is of a similar type and scope of beach activities that routinely has occurred and continues be held on this and other beaches across the State. Such activities have resulted in no known significant impacts, whether immediate or cumulative, to the natural, environmental and/or cultural resources in the area. As such staff believes that the proposed event would involve negligible or no expansion or change in use of the subject area beyond that previously existing.

Various government agencies and interest groups were solicited for comments.

- A. The standard terms and conditions of the most current right-of-entry permit form, as may be amended from time to time; and
- B. Such other terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to best serve the interests of the State.



Cumulative Impact of Planned Successive Actions in Same Place Significant?:

No. The temporary use of the land for beach recreation activities such as volleyball will not result in any significant cumulative impact.

Action May Have Significant Impact on Particularly Sensitive Environment?:

No. There are no sensitive environmental issues involved with the proposed use of the property.

Analysis: In the past, permits were issued for similar types of events on

the beach in the area, which have resulted in no known significant impacts to the natural and environmental resources in the area. As such, staff believes that the proposed event would involve negligible or no expansion or change in use of the subject area beyond that previously

existing.
