Request for Authorization to issue a month-to-month Revocable Permits (RP) to Na Pali Sea Tours, Inc., for storage of dry goods, tools, parts, supplies and equipment for repairs and maintenance for tour boat operations, situated at Pier 1, Port Allen Harbor, island of Kauai, Tax Map Key (TMK) Nos. (4) 2-1-003:006 (P) and (4) 2-1-003:020 (P), Governor's Executive Order No. 1047

LEGAL REFERENCE:

Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS), Sections 171-6, 171-11, 171-13, 171-17, 171-55, and 171-59, as amended.

APPLICANT:

Na Pali Sea Tours, Inc. (Applicant), is a domestic profit corporation whose mailing address is P.O. Box 51004, Eleele, Hawaii 96705.

CHARACTER OF USE:

For storage of dry goods, tools, parts, supplies and equipment for repairs and maintenance for tour boat operations.

LOCATION:

Portion of Government lands at Pier 1, Port Allen Harbor, island of Kauai, TMK Nos. (4) 2-1-003:006 (P) and (4) 2-1-003:020 (P), as shown on enclosed Exhibit A.

CONSIDERATION:

Month-to-month rent determined by appraisal as of January 1, 2021, for RPs in Port Allen Harbor, Kauai.

LAND TITLE STATUS:

Governor's Executive Order No. 1047 for Port Allen Harbor, to be under the control and management of the State of Hawaii, Department of Transportation (HDOT).

TRUST LAND STATUS:

Subsection 5(a) (Non-ceded Lands).

CURRENT USE STATUS:

The Applicant currently occupies portions of Port Allen Harbor, island of Kauai, for storage of dry goods, tools, parts, supplies and equipment for repairs and maintenance for tour boat operations. The HDOT has been reviewing all month-to-month RPs to ensure compliance with and applicability to HRS, Sections 171-17 and 171-55. The HDOT is updating the Applicant's permit with current appraised rates and updated permit terms as applicable.

CHAPTER 343 - ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT:

This use is exempt from the Office of Planning and Sustainable Development, and Environmental Review Program requirements pursuant to Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR), Subchapter 11-200.1, which exempts the following:

“Exemption Type 1: Operations, repairs, or maintenance of existing structures, facilities, equipment or topographical features, involving minor expansion or minor change of use beyond that previously existing.”

The HDOT deems the action as de minimis and exempts it from the preparation of an exemption notice in accordance with HAR, Subchapter 11-200.1-16(b). The exemption declaration for the action described above, based on the Exemption List for the HDOT, reviewed and concurred to by the Environmental Advisory Council on February 1, 2022, is as follows:

Exemption Type 1, Part 1:

- No. A1. “Repair or maintain buildings, office space, sheds, parking structures, warehouses, utility systems, aircraft aprons and hardstands, hangars, tunnels and other similar structures or facilities necessary for the continued function and use, and to meet current local, state and federal standards and regulations.”

Exemption Type 8, Part 1:

- No. 8g. “Creation or extension of leases, revocable permits or easements involving negligible or minor expansion or change of use beyond that previously existing.”

REMARKS:

The Applicant is a family owned and operated charter business on Kauai for over 30 years. The Applicant was the first to offer both catamaran and raft adventure tours of the Na Pali Coast. All tours are operated by experienced United States Coast Guard licensed boat captains and skilled crew who are educated in Kauai wildlife, conservation, and history.

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RECOMMENDATION:

Based on this submittal, testimony, and facts presented, the HDOT recommends that the Board finds that approving the issuance of two month-to-month RPs to the Applicant, including its conditions and rent, will serve the best interest of the State.

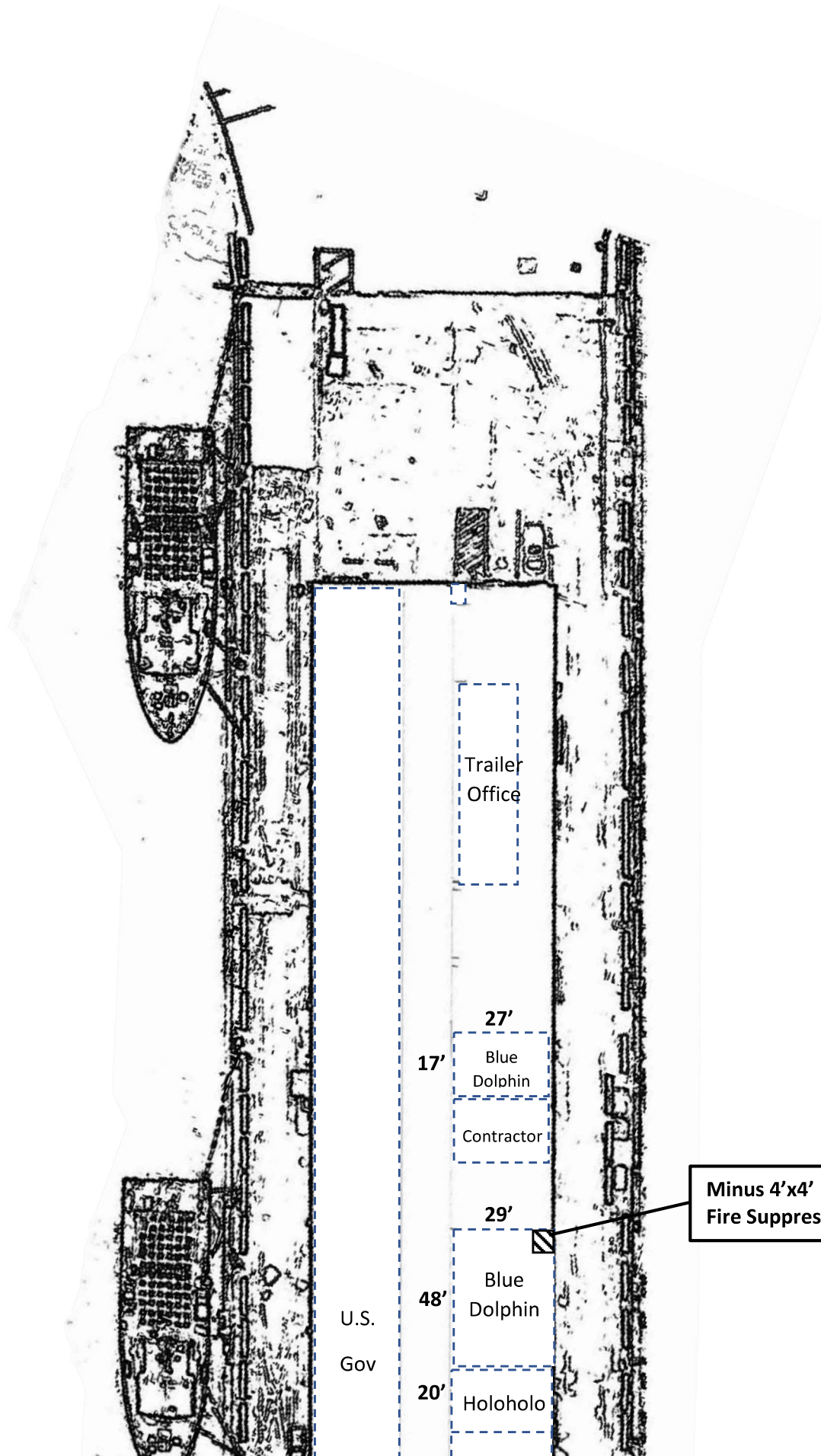
