It is imperative that we preserve these important spiritual sites to perpetuate Hawaiian culture and traditions of honoring the akua, aumakua, and our past ancestors.

Thus, there is no better way to do this than through the community, through I Ola Wailuanui, who aims to establish a place of cultural enrichment, historical preservation, land conservation, and spiritual nourishment.
