SUBJECT:

Request for administrative enforcement and penalties for alleged violations of Hawaii Revised Statutes Section 200-39 (Kaneohe Bay commercial ocean use activities; permits; restrictions) and Hawaii Administrative Rule Sections 13-256-3 (Commercial use permit or catamaran registration certificate requirements) and/or 13-253-73 against Ohana Kayak Rentals and Ms. Janell Jensen, individually and as owner of Ohana Kayak Rentals, both jointly and severally, for allegedly offering commercial ocean recreational equipment for commercial ocean use activity within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters, and/or delivering for hire or prepositioning for hire within one thousand feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay, on the Island of O'ahu, such commercial ocean recreational equipment for these purposes, and advertising these illegal activities, all without a commercial use permit issued by the department, on at least five separate dates, and for allegedly conducting these prohibited commercial activities on Sundays and/or federal holidays on at least two of those dates, for a total of at least seven (7) separate violations.

The Board may go into Executive Session pursuant to Section 92-5(a)(4), Hawaii Revised Statutes, in order to consult with its attorney on questions and issues pertaining to the Board's powers, duties, privileges, immunities, and liabilities.

SUMMARY:

This submittal requests that the Board of Land and Natural Resources (Board) find Ohana Kayak Rentals and Janell Jensen, individually and as owner of Ohana Kayak Rentals, both jointly and severally, in violation of Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Section 200-39, Kaneohe Bay commercial ocean use activities; permits; restrictions, and Hawaii Administrative Rule (HAR) Sections 13-256-3 (Commercial use permit or catamaran registration certificate requirements) and 13-256-73 (Kaneohe Bay ocean waters), for illegally conducting commercial ocean use activity within Kaneohe Bay

waters; advertising or otherwise offering any commercial ocean use activity or equipment for such activity within Kaneohe Bay waters; and/or for delivering for hire or pre-positioning within one thousand feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay for hire, such commercial ocean recreational equipment by providing kayaks for rent from a location within 1,000 feet of the Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters shoreline and for advertising of the same, without a valid commercial use permit (CUP) from the Department of Land and Natural Resources' Division of Boating and Ocean Recreation (DOBOR), including on Sundays and federal holidays, as prohibited by HRS Section 200-39(e) and HAR Section 13-256-73(c)(1).

DOBOR recommends that the Board issue seven separate administrative fines totaling thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) for the violations alleged herein, as authorized by Hawaii Revised Statutes (HRS) Sections 200-14.5(c) and 200-39(j).

DOBOR hereby alleges violations as follows:

Against: Janell Jensen individually, and Ohana Kayak Rentals, both

jointly and severally

Dates of incidents: November 23, 2023,

November 28, 2023, December 31, 2023, January 2, 2024, February 24, 2024

Location of incidents: Within 1,000 feet of the shoreline of Kāne'ohe Bay Ocean

Waters, O'ahu

Advertisements in print; by word of mouth; or online,

including through social media

Violations: Five (5) counts of illegally conducting commercial ocean use

activity and/or offering, providing, delivering, or pre-setting any commercial ocean use equipment for such activity, and advertising for the same, without a permit in violation of HRS

Section 200-39 (Kaneohe Bay commercial ocean use activities; permits; restrictions) HAR Section 13-256-3

(Commercial use permit or catamaran registration certificate

requirements); and

Two (2) counts of engaging in prohibited commercial ocean

use activities on Sundays and federal holidays and

prohibited advertisement or offering of commercial ocean use equipment for such activity within Kaneohe Bay waters,

without a permit, in violation of HRS Section 200-39(e) and HAR Section 13-256-73(c)(1).

Recommended Penalty:

Administrative fines totaling thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) for seven (7) separate violations of HRS Section 200-39 and/or HAR Sections 13-256-3 & -73 occurring on at least five (5) separate dates, pursuant to HRS Section 200-14.5(c), broken down as follows:

INTRODUCTION:

Pursuant to HRS Section 200-39, advertising or otherwise offering commercial ocean use equipment for commercial ocean use activity within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters is prohibited without a CUP from DOBOR. HRS Section 200-39(k) provides that "Commercial ocean use activity" means and includes "(2) Providing any commercial ocean recreational equipment for rent or hire; or (3) Delivering for hire or pre-positioning within one thousand feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay for hire, any commercial ocean recreational equipment"; and "Commercial ocean recreational equipment" includes kayaks. HRS Section 200-39(c) provides that

advertisement of unpermitted commercial use activities or commercial ocean recreational equipment shall be prima facie evidence that the owner of the advertised commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment disseminated or directed the dissemination of the advertisement and that the commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment is being operated in the location being advertised. HRS section 200-39(e) further provides that commercial ocean use activities are prohibited on Sundays and federal holidays. Pursuant to HAR Section 13-256-3, in order to conduct commercial activities in state ocean waters, an operator must obtain a valid commercial use permit (CUP) issued by DOBOR. And pursuant to HAR Section 13-256-73, all commercial ocean use activities in Kaneohe Bay ocean waters re prohibited on Sundays and federal holidays. As of the date of this submittal, neither Ms. Jensen individually nor Ohana Kayak Rentals has a valid CUP with DOBOR for kayak rentals for ocean use activities in Kaneohe Bay ocean waters, and for each of the instances constituting a violation alleged herein, neither Ms. Jensen nor Ohana Kayak Rentals held a valid CUP on the date of the alleged offense.

DOBOR's O'ahu staff and an Officer with the Division of Conservation and Resources Enforcement (DOCARE) observed Ms. Jensen offering kayak rental equipment and/or delivering for hire or pre-positioning within one thousand feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay for hire such kayak rental equipment for commercial ocean use activity within Kaneohe Bay waters on multiple separate occasions—including Sundays and/or federal holidays—without a valid CUP. Ms. Jensen's residence, where the kayak rentals are being provided by Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals, is less than 1,000-feet from the shoreline of Kane'ohe Bay ocean waters. (see Exhibit D)

Staff have reason to believe that Ms. Jensen individually and Ohana Kayak Rentals have offered kayak rentals on numerous other occasions than those enumerated here. DOBOR staff sent Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals a letter on October 16, 2023 providing notice to immediately cease and desist the unauthorized kayak rentals. Ms. Jensen then contacted DOBOR staff by phone on October 24, 2023 to discuss the October 16, 2023 letter.

Further, the Hawaii Business Registration for "Ohana Kayak Rentals" is active as of this submittal, until its expiration on May 7, 2027. Ms. Jensen is listed as the business's "registrant." These facts further suggest that the entity has knowingly continued to conduct business in the State of Hawaii.

It is therefore reasonable to expect that Ms. Jensen individually, and by extension, Ohana Kayak Rentals, had full notice of the restrictions on providing kayaks for rent

within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters, as well as knowledge that she was engaging in unpermitted commercial kayak rentals and that failure to comply with the applicable restrictions could result in citations, fines, and impoundment of the ocean equipment pursuant to HRS Section 200-39 and HAR Sections 13-256-3.

FACTUAL BACKGROUND:

Ms. Jensen operates a kayak rental business under the trade name "Ohana Kayak Rentals" from her residence. Neither Ms. Jensen nor Ohana Kayak Rentals currently hold a valid CUP. No CUPs are currently being issued for Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters pursuant to HAR Section 13-256-73(p), which prohibits any increase in commercial activity in Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters over the level existing on July 1, 1993. And not even permitted commercial activity in Kaneohe Bay ocean waters is permitted on Sundays and federal holidays. HRS § 200-39(e); HAR § 13-256-73(c)(1). Further, Ms. Jensen is advertising her kayak rental business online. DOBOR staff found advertisements for kayak rentals on business pages for "Ohana Kayak Rentals" on Facebook⁵ and Yelp.⁶

The following timeline summarizes the incidents between October 16, 2023 and February 24, 2024, underlying DOBOR's recommendations to find Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals in violation of HRS Section 200-39, and HAR Sections 13-256-3 & -73. DOBOR pictures and documentation are included as **EXHIBIT D**. As shown in **EXHIBIT D**, Google Map measurements show that Ms. Jensen's residence, where the kayak rentals are being provided by Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals, is less than 500 feet from the shoreline of Kane'ohe Bay ocean waters. A DOCARE report generated from an interaction with Ms. Jensen is included as **EXHIBIT E**.

- May 15, 2023: DOBOR staff is notified that kayak rentals are blocking public access near Hunalepo Street, which is a connecting street to luiu Street, where Ms. Jensen is providing kayaks for rent. Ms. Jensen is photographed giving instructions to the kayakers at the public access point. This instance is being provided as background information and not included in the counts of violation because it occurred before Ms. Jensen received the cease and desist letter from DOBOR. (see EXHIBIT D)
- September 25, 2023: DOBOR staff is notified about illegal kayak rentals in Kāne'ohe. Two individuals are pictured; one is carrying kayak equipment (paddle, seats). There are two kayaks strapped to the top of their vehicle, which is parked on the side of the road near the public access frequently recommended by Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals for customers to launch their rented kayaks. This instance is being provided as background information and not included in the counts of violation because it occurred before Ms. Jensen and

Ohana Kayak Rentals received the cease and desist letter from DOBOR. (see **EXHIBIT D**)

- October 16, 2023: DOBOR sends Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals a letter providing notice of the violations of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3. The letter also instructs Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals to immediately cease and desist engaging in unpermitted kayak rentals in violation of these laws. The letter included notice that failure to comply could result in citations, fines, and impoundment of ocean equipment. (see EXHIBIT A)
- October 24, 2023: DOBOR staff speaks with Ms. Jensen about her activities and the activities of Ohana Kayak Rentals over the phone, where Ms. Jensen confirms receipt of the October 16, 2023 letter. Ms. Jensen asked what would happen if she and Ohana Kayak Rentals continued to conduct the kayak rentals described herein and was informed that she and Ohana Kayak Rentals, both jointly and severally, would be legally responsible for all of the illegal actions and for any findings of violation(s) and liabilities arising out of those findings. Additionally, Ms. Jensen stated to DOBOR staff that Ohana Kayak Rentals is her business that is operated out of her residence and is used as a source of income. (see EXHIBIT B)
- November 23, 2023: DOBOR staff receives a complaint about Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals continuing to offer kayak rentals out of her residence (which is located within 500-feet of shoreline of Kaneohe Bay ocean waters). Two individuals are seen engaging in a transaction with Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals. The complainant provides a picture showing what appears to be a kayak offered by Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals loaded on top of the vehicle within 1,000-feet of the shoreline of Kaneohe Bay ocean waters. This is the first alleged violation of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3. Because November 23, 2023 is a federal holiday, this alleged instance of violation also includes a first violation of HRS Section 200-39(e) and HAR Section 13-256-73(c)(1). (see EXHIBIT D)
- November 28, 2023: DOBOR staff receives a complaint about Ms. Jensen providing kayak rentals from her residence. The complainant provides pictures showing vehicles with kayaks attached to the roof of the vehicles. Additionally, the member of the public photographed the same vehicle, an orange SUV, at the public beach access on Hunalepo, which is within 1,000-feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay. Two individuals are carrying a kayak to load onto their vehicle. This is the second alleged violation of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3. (see EXHIBIT D)

- December 31, 2023: DOBOR staff receives a complaint about Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals providing kayak rentals from her residence. The complainant provides pictures showing customers at Ms. Jensen's residence, which is located within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay, with kayaks offered, provided, or delivered by Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals and intended for use within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters loaded onto their vehicles. One customer is obstructing traffic with their car doors at the same public access point at Hunalepo. This is the third alleged violation of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3. Because December 31, 2023 was a Sunday, this alleged instance of violation also includes a second violation of HRS Section 200-39(e) and HAR Section 13-256-73(c)(1). (see EXHIBIT D)
- <u>January 2, 2024</u>: DOBOR staff receives a complaint about Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals providing kayak rentals from Ms. Jensen's residence, which is located within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay. The complainant provides pictures of an individual strapping a kayak offered, provided, or delivered by Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals and intended for use within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters onto his vehicle with Ms. Jensen and another individual present. This is the fourth alleged violation of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3. (see **EXHIBIT D**)
- DOCARE Officer Kopaciewicz assisted Officer Thompson and Officer Dombrowski in an undercover operation to investigate Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals for offering, providing, delivering, and/or advertising illegal kayak rentals within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay and/or for use within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters. On February 20, 2024 Officer Kopaciewicz contacted Ms. Jensen to make a reservation for a single kayak rental for use within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters for February 24, 2024, where he was told by Ms. Jensen to call the day when there would be a better gauge of the weather. Officer Kopaciewicz called back on February 23, 2024 and reserved a single kayak for these purposes February 24, 2024.
- February 24, 2024: Officer Kopaciewicz arrives at Ms. Jensen's residence, 47-183 luiu Street, Kaneohe, HI 96744, which is located within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay. At approximately 8:12am, Officer Kopaciewicz texts Ms. Jensen upon his arrival and is greeted by Ms. Jensen on behalf of Ohana Kayak Rentals. Ms. Jensen "educated" Officer Kopaciewicz, using labeled photographs on her phone, about landmarks to look out for to navigate and how to be a good steward in Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters, thereby demonstrating that the commercial ocean recreational rental equipment was intended for use within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters. She also had Officer Kopaciewicz complete a waiver document. Ms. Jensen began loading (i.e., delivering and/or prepositioning within one thousand feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay) the kayak gear, and after Officer Kopaciewicz completed the waiver, Officer Kopaciewicz

and Ms. Jensen loaded the kayak into Officer Kopaciewicz's truck bed. At 8:45am, uniformed DOCARE Officers Thompson and Dombrowski approached Officer Kopaciewicz and Ms. Jensen, where they informed them that a DOBOR CUP was required to conduct kayak rental operations. Officer Thompson and Dombrowski cited Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals for violations of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3. This is the fifth alleged violation of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3. (see **EXHIBIT E**)

As of April 5, 2024, Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals are still advertising kayak rentals for use in Kaneohe Bay ocean waters, to be provided/ delivered/ or prepositioned from Ms. Jensen's residence located within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay, through the publicly accessible "Ohana Kayak Rentals" Facebook page, which appears to be the primary method of soliciting business, and which represents a continuing violation of HRS Section 200-39(c).

REGULATORY AUTHORITY:

A. Statutory Basis for Violation

HRS Section 200-39 was amended by Act 232 (2023) and provides in relevant part:

- (b) No person shall conduct any commercial ocean use activity within Kaneohe Bay waters without a permit issued by the department.
- (c) No person shall advertise or otherwise offer any commercial ocean use activity or equipment for such activity within Kaneohe Bay waters for which the person does not have a permit from the department. Advertisement in print; by word of mouth; or online in any form, including through social media, of unpermitted commercial ocean use activities or commercial ocean recreational equipment shall be prima facie evidence that:
 - (1) The owner of the advertised commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment disseminated or directed the dissemination of the advertisement in that form and manner; and
 - (2) The commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment is being operated at the location advertised.

The burden of proof shall be on a person charged with a violation of this section to establish that the equipment is not being used for unpermitted commercial ocean use activity or that the person's conduct is pursuant to a permit, lease, or license issued by the department.

- (e) On Sundays and federal holidays, all commercial ocean use activities shall be prohibited.
 - [...]
- (j) Any penalties established in rule pursuant to this section shall be separate and in addition to any other fees, charges, and fines imposed by the department.

HRS Section 200-39(k) also provides in relevant part:

"Commercial ocean recreational equipment" means . . . kayaks . . . or watercraft for any other similar commercial activity.

"Commercial ocean use activity" means and includes:

- (1) Any commercial operation of commercial ocean recreational equipment, or any other similar commercial ocean activity;
- (2) Providing any commercial ocean recreational equipment for rent or hire; or
- (3) Delivering for hire or pre-positioning within one thousand feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay for hire, any commercial ocean recreational equipment.

Haw. Rev. Stat. § 200-39(k).

B. Administrative Basis for Violation

Under HAR Section 13-256-3 (Commercial use permit or catamaran registration certificate requirements), all persons engaging in commercial activity on state ocean waters are required to obtain a commercial use permit (CUP) from DOBOR:

All operators of commercial vessels, water craft or water sports equipment or activities conducting commercial tours or instruction on State ocean waters must obtain a commercial use permit or where applicable a catamaran registration certificate to be issued by the department, except for those operating out of a commercial harbor. The applicant for such permit shall comply with the applicable provisions stated in sections 13-231-50 to 13-231-70.

Under HAR Section 13-256-73(c) (Kaneohe Bay ocean waters), "(1) All commercial ocean use activities in Kaneohe Bay ocean waters are prohibited on Sundays and federal holidays."

The HAR further establishes:

"Commercial activity" means to engage in any action or attempt to engage in any action designed for profit, which includes, but is not limited to, the exchange or buying and selling of commodities; the providing of services relating to or connected with trade, traffic, or commerce in general; any activity performed by the commercial operator or its employees or agents in connection with the delivery of such commodities or services; and the soliciting of business, including the display or distribution of notices, business cards, or advertisements for commercial promotional purposes.

Haw. Admin. R. § 13-230-8 (Definitions).

C. Administrative Penalties

Fines for violations of the administrative rules identified above are set forth in HAR Section 13-230-4, which provides, in relevant part, that:

Except as otherwise provided by law, the board is authorized to set, charge, and collect administrative fines and to recover administrative fees and costs, including attorney's fees and costs, or bring legal action to recover administration fines, fees and costs, including attorney's fees and costs, or payment for damages or for the cost to correct damages resulting from violation of subtitle 8 of title 12 or any rule adopted thereunder in accordance with section 200-14.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes. Each day or instance of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Haw. Admin. R. § 13-230-4(b).

Under HRS Section 200-14.5(a), the Board is authorized to "set, charge, and collect administrative fines and to recover administrative fees and costs, including attorney's fees and costs, or bring legal action to recover administrative fines and fees and costs, including attorney's fees and costs." And like HAR § 13-230-4(b), the HRS also provides that "[e]ach day or instance of violation shall constitute a separate offense." Haw. Rev. Stat. § 200.14.5(a).

For any violation that does not involve pollution of the waters of the State, the HRS sets the limitations on fine amounts for all violations as follows:

- (1) For a first violation or a violation beyond five years of a previous violation, a fine of not more than \$5,000;
- (2) For a second violation within five years of a previous violation, by a fine of not more than \$10,000; and
- (3) For a third or subsequent violation within five years of the last violation, by a fine of not more than \$15,000.

Haw. Rev. Stat. § 200-14.5(c).

Additionally, HAR Section 13-231-1(d) (General statement and restrictions on mooring dormant vessels) provides, in relevant part:

The department reserves the right to restrict the use of state facilities to those who are in compliance with all state and federal laws and rules and make full and timely payment of their fees and charges. Failure to comply with this section shall be cause for termination of any use permit and for refusal or withholding the granting of any future use permit requests.

Under HAR Section 13-231-1(d), the Board therefore has the authority to prevent a person from obtaining *any* future DOBOR use permits if the person is not in compliance with state and federal laws and rules, and the Board may determine the amount of time this restriction will be in place.

APPLICATION OF LAW AND RECOMMENDED PENALTY:

A. Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals offered illegal commercial ocean recreational equipment (kayak rentals) for illegal commercial ocean use activity, thereby engaging in "commercial activity".

The activities that Ms. Jensen engaged in without a valid CUP, in violation of HRS Section 200-39 and HAR Sections 13-256-3 & -73, involve unauthorized commercial activity (offering, providing, delivering, pre-positioning and/or advertising kayak rentals) within 1,000 of any shoreline of Kāne'ohe Bay and intended for use within Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters. Additionally, Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals' Facebook page advertises the location of her residence as being "the closest to the sandbar," which is a reference to a location within Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters.

There is substantial and well-documented evidence showing that Ms. Jensen continues to advertise for, offer, provide, deliver and/or pre-position illegal kayak rentals from her residence, which is located within 1,000 feet of any Kāne'ohe Bay shoreline, and which rentals are intended for use within Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters. Neither Ms. Jensen nor Ohana Kayak Rentals have not removed any of the online advertisements from Facebook, nor have they removed any of the Yelp or Google review pages. It is reasonable to assume that Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals are aware of the unlawfulness of their provision of kayaks for rent, as described above, pursuant to the October 16, 2023 cease and desist letter, and that they have chosen to ignore the notice.

There is also an extensive history of complaints from various members of the public regarding the illegal commercial activities described above by Ms. Jensen and her company, Ohana Kayak Rentals. Many of these complaints are from Ms. Jensen's

immediate residential community. Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals continue to disregard the community's concern for these illegal commercial kayak operations, as described above, by allowing customers to disrupt the neighborhood with increased traffic and safety concerns.

Pursuant to HRS Section 200-39(k), Ms. Jensen's and Ohana Kayak Rentals' kayak rental operation constitutes "commercial ocean use activity" under each of the factors provided therein, and the kayaks at issue constitute "commercial ocean recreational equipment" under the statute. It is blatantly obvious that Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals are advertising and offering kayaks for rental from a location within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kaneohe Bay and for use within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters, all without a DOBOR CUP. Furthermore, evidence establishes that Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals' illegal activity is also being conducted on Sundays and federal holidays, which are also, separately, prohibited by law.

As shown on the Google Map in **EXHIBIT D**, Ms. Jensen's residence, where she offers, provides, delivers, or pre-positions the kayaks for rent and advertises for the same, is located within 1,000 feet from the shoreline of Kāne'ohe Bay ocean waters, showing that these activities are occurring within the prohibited area. Furthermore, by all accounts, these rentals are intended for use within the prohibited area of Kaneohe Bay ocean waters.

B. Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals, jointly and severally, have failed to comply with legal permitting requirements and therefore engaged in illegal commercial activities.

According to DOBOR's records, neither Ms. Jensen nor Ohana Kayak Rentals has ever applied for, or obtained, a valid CUP from DOBOR, as required by HRS Section 200-39 and HAR Section 13-256-3, in order to engage in the commercial ocean use activity, as described more fully above. The October 16, 2023 letter sent by DOBOR notified Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals that they were required to obtain a CUP in order to legally operate the kayak rental business in the manner described. Ms. Jensen confirmed that she read the letter when she called DOBOR to follow up about it. Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals continue to operate the business without a CUP and ignore DOBOR's notice to cease and desist providing illegal kayak rentals within 1,000 feet of any Kaneohe Bay shoreline and for use within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters. In fact, during the phone conversation with DOBOR staff, Ms. Jensen asked what would happen if her business were to continue to operate without a CUP and was informed that she and Ohana Kayak Rentals, both jointly and severally, would be legally responsible for any unlawful actions. It is apparent that Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals have chosen to disregard the known, potential consequences of operating an unpermitted business and that Ms. Jensen individually and Ohana Kayak Rentals, both jointly and severally, should be held legally responsible for continuing to provide the

illegal kayak rentals, as more fully described above, without the valid CUP required by law.

Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals have shown a blatant disregard for the laws and protections put in place to ensure public safety and natural resource conservation through repeated and on-going violations of the above-summarized commercial activity restrictions.

C. Administrative Penalties are authorized by Hawaii Revised Statutes and the Hawaii Administrative Rules for each of Ms. Jensen's and Ohana Kayak Rentals' illegal activities described above, including but not limited to the seven alleged violations enumerated here.

Pursuant to HRS Section 200.14.5(a) and HAR Section 13-230-4(b), each day or instance of violation is considered a separate offense.

As evidenced herein and by the attached exhibits, Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals were observed on at least five dates, two of which were Sundays and/or federal holidays, bringing the total number of violations to seven (7) (not counting the on-going advertising violations), conducting unlawful commercial ocean use activity or advertising or offering equipment for such activity from a location within 1,000 feet of any shoreline of Kanoehe Bay, and for activity to take place within Kaneohe Bay ocean waters. Pursuant to HRS Section 200-14.5(c), Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals can therefore be fined five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) for each violation.

There are no mitigating factors that DOBOR staff believes would justify a lesser fine for the violations listed above. Ms. Jensen had full notice of the applicable regulations, per the October 16, 2023 cease and desist letter sent by DOBOR, and the citation issued by DOCARE. Additionally, Ms. Jensen chose to continue to violate the commercial activity restrictions on multiple occasions after being notified of the infractions. It is essential that the Department impose equivalent consequences for repeated, blatant violations of HRS and HAR restrictions, particularly when the violations appear to be ongoing.

Due to Ms. Jensen's disregard for DOBOR's rules, and in order to curb any temptation to further violate HRS or HAR restrictions in the future, staff recommends that the Board issue the maximum administrative fines to Ms. Jensen: a total amount of thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) for the alleged violations of HRS 200-39(e) and HAR Section 13-256-3 as described herein.

Pursuant to HRS Section 200-14.5(c), DOBOR has calculated the recommended fines as follows:

Staff's additional requested penalty under HAR Section 13-231-1(d) — to prohibit Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals from obtaining any type of use permit from DOBOR, including but not limited to mooring permits and CUPs, for twenty-four (24) months from the date of this submittal — is also warranted here because of the egregiousness of the violations. Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals continued to violate commercial operation regulations after being notified of the illegality of their activities. DOBOR believes that preventing issuance of use permits in the future, and thereby preventing many types of boating and commercial ocean recreation activities, will help to deter anyone considering engaging in illegal commercial activity.

RECOMMENDATIONS:

DOBOR requests that the Board:

- 1. Find that Ohana Kayak Rentals and Janell Jensen, individually and as owner of Ohana Kayak Rentals, both jointly and severally, committed at least two (2) administrative violations of HRS Section 200-39(e) and HAR Section 13-256-73(c)(1), and at least five (5) administrative violations of HRS Section 200-39(c) and HAR Section 13-256-3, as described above, and authorize the issuance of a Notice of Violation for the seven violations described herein:
- 2. All of the above-described actions were intentionally taken by Ohana Kayak Rentals and by Ms. Jensen, individually and as owner of Ohana Kayak Rentals, and that both parties shall be held jointly and severally liable for all penalties imposed.
- 3. Authorize the following penalties for the violations:
 - a. Issue administrative fines totaling thirty-five thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) against Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals, both jointly and severally, for their violations of HRS Section 200-39 and HAR Sections 13-256-3 & -73, pursuant to HRS Section 200-14.5(c) and other applicable authority, and which fines shall be paid to the Department within ninety (90) days; and
 - b. Prohibit Ms. Jensen and Ohana Kayak Rentals from obtaining any type of use permit from DOBOR, including, but not limited to CUPs, for twenty-four (24) months from the date of this submittal, pursuant to HAR Section 13-231-1(d). This prohibition shall apply to any vessel owned by Ms. Jensen and/or Ohana Kayak Rentals, in-full or in-part, any vessel Ms. Jensen and/or Ohana Kayak Rentals operates under lease, exclusively or in-part, any vessel owned by or leased to a business entity of any kind in which Ms. Jensen and/or Ohana Kayak Rentals is a majority owner or shareholder, and to any vessel Ms. Jensen and/or Ohana Kayak Rentals may otherwise operate in State waters during the 24-month period.
- 4. Delegate authority to the Chairperson to effectuate the above recommendations and take any other actions in furtherance of enforcing the subject violations, subject to such conditions as may be prescribed by the Chairperson to serve the best interests of the State, without further consultation from the Board, subject to review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General; and

5. Delegate authority to the Chairperson to enter into a settlement agreement with Ms. Jensen and/or Ohana Kayak Rentals, subject to review and approval by the Department of the Attorney General.

NOTICE TO IMMEDIATELY CEASE AND DESIST

Aloha:

Our office has been made aware that you are engaging in commercial activity in state ocean waters without a Commercial Use Permit, as required by law and administrative rules.

YOU ARE HEREBY INFORMED that you are in violation of Hawaii Revised Statutes Section 200-39(c), as amended by Act 232, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, which states in relevant part:

No person shall advertise or otherwise offer any commercial ocean use activity or equipment for such activity within Kaneohe Bay waters for which the person does not have a permit from the department. Advertisement in print; by word of mouth; or online in any form, including through social media, of unpermitted commercial ocean use activities or commercial ocean recreational equipment shall be prima facie evidence that:

- (1) The owner of the advertised commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment disseminated or directed the dissemination of the advertisement in that form and manner; and
- (2) The commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment is being operated at the location advertised.

YOU ARE FURTHER INFORMED that you are also in violation of Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 13-256-3, which states in relevant part:

All operators of commercial vessels, water craft or watersports equipment or activities conducting commercial tours or instruction on State ocean waters must obtain a commercial use permit or where applicable a catamaran registration certificate to be issued by the department, except for those operating out of a state commercial harbor.

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to immediately cease and desist all unpermitted commercial activities, including advertisement, renting of ocean related equipment, and any commercial ocean recreation tours or services. Failure to comply will constitute grounds for enforcement action including, but not limited to, citations, fines, and impoundment of vessels and equipment.

All,

I just got an earful and grilled from Janell Jansen from a phone conversation this afternoon. This phone call confirms she received the Cease and Desist Letter for Ohana Kayak Rentals that I sent to her, dated: 10/16/2023. I've provided my email address for her to send her inquiries and complaints. During the conversation, I also explained that many of her questions/concerns/complaints may involve different Divisions within the DLNR and other agencies. I cannot account for everything as that may be outside of my jurisdiction and she should email her concerns/comments. She stated she has been calling many agencies and may be contacting yours as well.

The conversation I had consisted of the following (my Answers to her in blue):

- Who made the complaint(s)? How many?
 - A: The letter was sent in response to complaints as well as notification of the Act 232 as referenced in the letter.
- Who else received the letter?
 - o A: She's the first one, we'll be addressing others as information becomes available.
- This violates her Amendment/Constitutional Rights.
 - A: Her commercial operation is violating the HRS and HARs as references are in the letter, review the letter.
- She spoke to Bruce Swartz, DOBOR Oahu District Manager and it was stated that her operation was not viewed as a commercial operation.
 - A: If she reviews the letter, Act 232 is relatively new, at the time she spoke with Bruce, it did not apply.
- She's called the DCCA and AGs? Regarding the letter as we're restricting her from operating her business.
 - A: The notification letter indicates, she can no longer operate in the current manner.
- There are numerous other kayak operators doing the same thing such as Kamaaina Kids, the Marine Corps base, etc. I should look on Google for kayak rentals on Oahu and I can find all the other operators.
 - O Why didn't we send letters to them too?
 - A: We'll look into the concerns of other potential violations if she provides them (provided my email address) or as the information becomes available as they have different aspects to their operations.
- Where can she complain about persons walking on the reef?
 - A: DAR/DOCARE
- Why did she not receive a response when she's made complaints? To who? She doesn't recall.
- Why can't I stay on the phone with her to go over EVERY illegal operator?
 - A: Again, she can provide her concerns in writing and we can look into it. Can send by email.
- Someone threatened her and her 10 year old, keyed her car and threatened to shut down her business.
 - A: That's a separate issue she can report to whomever that jurisdiction falls under. It is not the same even if it concerns her business or a threat to it.
- Why can't I answer all her questions over the phone? Why does she need to put it in writing?
 - A: A written request to address concerns allows us to better provide an appropriate response.
- What are the fines? Is there a fine for continuing to operate? Is there any way around this?

- A: It is undetermined as to what fines, citations, etc. will be assessed. There is no way around this. She's been notified to cease and desist, what she does is entirely up to her.
- Who enforces this?
 - A: Could be multi-agencies.
- Will her items be confiscated?
 - o A: Possible.
- What will DOCARE do?
 - o A: She'll have to inquire with DOCARE.



Location of Ohana Kayak Rentals







On 2/23/2024, at approximately 1213 hours, I called Janell JENSEN and reserved a single kayak for 0800 hours on 2/24/2024.

SCENE

The scene of this crime is at the 47-183 Luiu Street, Kaneohe, HI, 96744. This location appeared to be private in a small neighborhood.

ARRIVAL

On 02/24/2024, at approximately 0812 hours, I parked my vehicle in the driveway of 47-183 Luiu Street, Kaneohe, HI, and waited for JENSEN to greet me. Upon texting JENSEN that I had arrived, she appeared from the house's front door several minutes later.

2. Online advertisement- Yelp review

On 12/6/2023 at approximately 0927 hours, I searched for Ohana Kayak Rentals on Google Maps, to which JENSEN's address is located (47-183 Iuiu Street, Kaneohe, HI 96744). In the "Overview" section, it states, "This is a local home kayak rental business. Nearest to shortest distance acces to the sandbar..." This is another clear indication to the sandbar located within Kaneohe Bay.

4. Registered business check through DCCA

On 12/6/2023 at approximately 0928 hours, I looked on the Department of Commerce and Consumer Affairs (DCCA) website to confirm that Ohana Kayak Rentals was a registered business, to which it was confirmed as well as owned by JENSEN.

5. Commercial use permit (CUP)

On 12/15/2023 at approximately 1030 hours, I met with DOBOR Administrator Ed UNDERWOOD and Deputy Administrator Meghan STATTS to confirm that Ohana Kayak Rentals did not possess a valid commercial use permit (CUP) issued by DOBOR. Both UNDERWOOD and STATTS confirmed this and had me meet with DOBOR Assistant Oahu District Manager Jenna KAWASUGI to clarify. KAWASUGI also confirmed no CUP issued to Ohana Kayak Rentals and mentioned her conversation with JENSEN after being called the day after being sent the cease-and-desist letter.

ADVERTISEMENT FOR KANEOHE BAY

JENSEN was informed that the DOBOR Administrators were made aware of her business advertising for kayak rentals within Kaneohe Bay, which was a violation of the newly amended Hawaii Revised Statute (HRS) 200-39(c) "Kaneohe Bay commercial use activities; permits; restrictions." I explained that her online advertisement on the Facebook webpage (Ohana Kayak Rentals) and her business showing up Google Maps at her residence clearly describing the sandbar, which falls within Kaneohe Bay and State ocean waters. And the reviews from guests also indicated JENSEN's name and her explaining to them about launching their kayaks by the public beach access close to her residence, which was still within the Kaneohe Bay and State ocean waters.

REQUEST FOR COMMERCIAL USE PERMIT (CUP)

Upon request for a valid CUP issued by DOBOR, JENSEN could not provide one. JENSEN was informed that she was not allowed to conduct any commercial activities and rentals of any water sports equipment in state ocean waters without a valid CUP, which I explained was provided in the cease-and desist letter sent by DOBOR. NOTICE TO IMMEDIATELY CEASE AND DESIST

Aloha:

Our office has been made aware that you are engaging in commercial activity in state ocean waters without a Commercial Use Permit, as required by law and administrative rules.

YOU ARE HEREBY INFORMED that you are in violation of Hawaii Revised Statutes Section 200-39(c), as amended by Act 232, Session Laws of Hawaii 2023, which states in relevant part:

No person shall advertise or otherwise offer any commercial ocean use activity or equipment for such activity within Kaneohe Bay waters for which the person does not have a permit from the department. Advertisement in print; by word of mouth; or online in any form, including through social media, of unpermitted commercial ocean use activities or commercial ocean recreational equipment shall be prima facie evidence that:

- (1) The owner of the advertised commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment disseminated or directed the dissemination of the advertisement in that form and manner; and
- (2) The commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment is being operated at the location advertised.

YOU ARE FURTHER INFORMED that you are also in violation of Hawaii Administrative Rule Section 13-256-3, which states in relevant part:

YOU ARE HEREBY ORDERED to immediately cease and desist all unpermitted commercial activities, including advertisement, renting of ocean related equipment, and any commercial ocean recreation tours or services. Failure to comply will constitute grounds for enforcement action including, but not limited to, citations, fines, and impoundment of vessels and equipment.

§200-39 Kaneohe Bay commercial ocean use activities;

- permits; restrictions. (a) Any other provision of this chapter to the contrary notwithstanding, no person shall operate thrill craft, parasailing, water sledding, or commercial high speed boating unless the person meets the requirements of section 200-37 and all rules adopted by the department that regulate or restrict these activities.
- (b) No person shall conduct any commercial ocean use activity within Kaneohe Bay waters without a permit issued by the department.
- (c) No person shall advertise or otherwise offer any commercial ocean use activity or equipment for such activity within Kaneohe Bay waters for which the person does not have a permit from the department. Advertisement in print; by word of mouth; or online in any form, including through social media, of unpermitted commercial ocean use activities or commercial ocean recreational equipment shall be prima facie evidence that:
 - (1) The owner of the advertised commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment disseminated or directed the dissemination of the advertisement in that form and manner; and
 - (2) The commercial ocean use activity or commercial ocean recreational equipment is being operated at the location advertised.

The burden of proof shall be on a person charged with a violation of this section to establish that the equipment is not being used for unpermitted commercial ocean use activity or that the person's conduct is pursuant to a permit, lease, or license issued by the department.

- (d) Permits issued by the department for commercial ocean use activities in Kaneohe Bay shall be limited to the number and locations, by permit type and vessel and passenger capacity, provided in the Kaneohe Bay master plan developed pursuant to Act 208, Session Laws of Hawaii 1990, until applicable rules consistent with the master plan are adopted by the department; provided that the passenger capacity for snorkeling tours and glassbottom boat tours shall be set through rules adopted pursuant to chapter 91. No thrill craft permit may be transferred after June 21, 1998; provided that transfers of permits may be made at any time between family members.
- (e) On Sundays and federal holidays, all commercial ocean use activities shall be prohibited.
- (f) All rules adopted by the department with regard to Kaneohe Bay shall be drafted in consultation with the Kaneohe Bay regional council.

- \$13-256-2 <u>Interpretation.</u> (a) If any section of these rules is inconsistent with any law of the State of Hawaii, or any laws of the United States, or any rule, or standard established pursuant to federal law, the State law or federal law, rule or standard shall govern. Nothing contained in these rules shall be construed to limit the powers of any department or agency of the state.
- (b) These rules shall be construed liberally, consistent with the purpose stated in section 13-256-1.
- (c) In areas designated for a specific use, if another use is not specifically restricted, that use is presumed to be allowed in addition to the use for which the area is designated, unless otherwise prohibited by this chapter.
