Amend Prior Board Action of September 22, 2023, agenda item D-13; (1) Consent to Assign General Lease of Easement No. S-5175, (a) Shoji Kitami, Assignor to Masahiro Kitami, Assignee; (b) Masahiro Kitami Assignor, to Lukasz John Maj and Mary Liu Lan, Assignees; (2) Amend the Easement Conditions regarding Consent to Assignment and Insurance Provision; Kaneohe, Koolaupoko, Oahu, Tax Map Key: (1) 4-6-001:011seaward, as amended on January 12, 2024, under agenda item D-5.

This second amendment is to correct the legal capacity of assignor described in the prior board action after the appointment of Masahiro Kitami as the Ancillary Personal Representative of the Estate of Shoji Kitami.

BACKGROUND:

At its meeting of September 22, 2023, under agenda item D-13, the Board gave its consent to the above-described assignments of the subject easement ("GL5175") for pier and shed purposes.¹

When the Department of the Attorney General was requested to prepare the documentation pursuant to the 2023 approval, it was noted that Masahiro Kitami was identified as "successor in interest to Shoji Kitami" in the assignment document. However, there was no document that transferred GL5175 to Masahiro Kitami before his father, Shoji Kitami, passed away in early 2023. The applicant decided to open a probate proceeding in the State to establish his legal capacity to act on behalf of the estate of his father.

On January 12, 2024, under agenda item D-5, the Board authorized the issuance of an immediate management right-of-entry to the proposed assignees to manage the pier under GL $5175.^2$

On April 12, 2024, Masahiro Kitami was authorized by the Circuit Court of the First Circuit to perform the duties of Ancillary Personal Representative and to administer the estate according to law. Copy of the court document is attached as **Exhibit 1**.

Staff recommends the Board amend its prior action by correcting the legal capacity of

Masahiro Kitami in the title line, as described in the Recommendation section below.

<u>RECOMMENDATION</u>: That the Board:

A. Amend its prior Board action of September 22, 2023, under agenda item D-13 by revising the title line of the request to read:

(1) Consent to Assign General Lease of Easement No. S-5175, (a) Shoji Kitami, Assignor to Masahiro Kitami, Assignee; (b) Masahiro Kitami, Ancillary Personal Representative of the Estate of Shoji Kitami, Deceased, Assignor, to Lukasz John Maj and Mary Liu Lan, Assignees; (2) Amend the Easement Conditions regarding Consent to Assignment and Insurance Provision; Kaneohe, Koolaupoko, Oahu, Tax Map Key: (1) 4-6-001:011seaward.

B. Affirm that, except as amended hereby, all terms and conditions listed in its September 22, 2023 approval, as amended on January 12, 2024, shall remain the same.


